1. Read Joh. 4:7-10. A) Briefly explain the relationship between the Samaritans and the Jews in this passage. B) What does Jesus mean when he says, "living water"?
2. Read Joh. 4:11-15. A) Explain what Jesus means when he states, "will never be thirsty". B) In your opinion explain if she fully understood what Jesus was conveying and how does this apply to church today?
3. Read Joh. 4:28-30. A) What can you derive from the facts that during the heat of the day, this woman left her water-jar and went to the city. B) Considering this woman may have had a questionable past, why does the entire city believe and follow her?
4. Read Joh. 4:39-41. A) In this passage list and explain the two reasons many "believed in him". B) What does this passage tell us about "the power" of a testimony and how we must apply this today?
5. Conclude by reading John 4:42 in unison!
