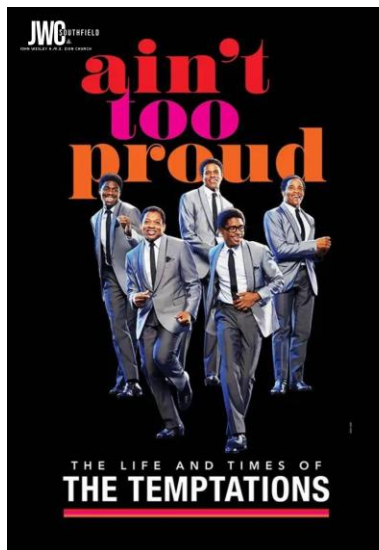
Do you have old eyeglasses lying around that you are no longer wearing?
