


# key uerse activity

How do you show your love to your parents? How do children show their love to their younger sisters and brothers? This is an example of showing love:

One day, a little 4-year-old girl stood up to say her speech in the Easter program, but she couldn't remember it. Her big sister, who was 10 years old, saw that her little sister was having trouble. The big sister got up and went to the front where her little sister was standing, knelt down, and whispered in her ear. Then the little sister started to say her speech.

The Bible tells us about the time when a woman showed great love to Jesus. People looked down on her because she lived a very sinful life. She learned that Jesus was having dinner at a nearby home, so she went to see Him. When she entered the

house, she kneeled down and washed Jesus' feet. In Jesus' day, people always needed their feet washed after traveling because there was no pavement, just dusty sandy roads. After she washed His feet, she kissed them. Then she poured perfume on His feet.


The people who were eating with Jesus complained, "Why is Jesus letting this sinful woman kiss his feet?"
