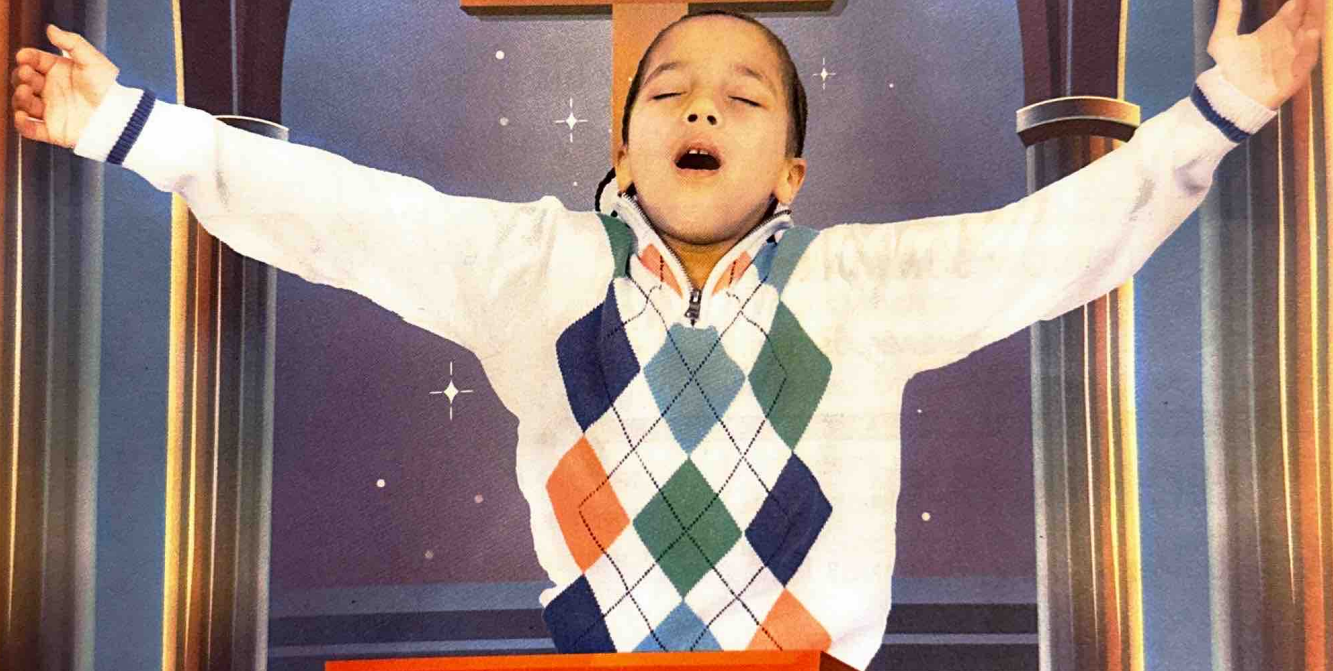

Two Great Gifts: Forgiveness and Grace

In 4th grade, Jonathan got into a lot of trouble at school. The teacher called his parents many times because he was disobedient. He was sent to the detention room five times for disturbing the class. He was sent home on suspension twice. One time he started a fight, and the other time he dumped a boy on the see-saw.

About a week before Jonathan was to start school for 5th grade, his father had a talk with him. They talked about how to stay out of trouble. Jonathan said he was sorry about how he behaved in 4th grade and promised to do better. When Jonathan said this, his father promised to take him on a trip to Disneyland next summer if he didn't get into trouble during the school year.

During 5th grade, Jonathan did get in trouble three times. The teacher called his parents about it. Jonathan was sad when he got into trouble. He really wanted to please his father.

On the last day of school, his father surprised him and told him they were going to Disneyland. His father said, "I could tell you were sorry when you did something wrong, so I forgive you for those times."

Jesus is like Jonathan's father. Jesus forgives us when we do wrong and are sorry. God's forgiveness is a gift. Many times in life, God blesses us when we don't deserve it. When we receive a blessing and didn't earn it, this is another gift. This gift is God's grace. When we pray, we should thank God for His forgiveness and His grace.
