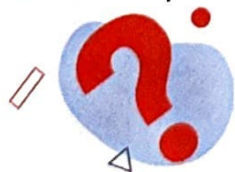
God Knows Me

Who do you know a lot about? Most of us know our family members better than we know everyone else because we are around them often. Who knows you? Our parents and our sisters and brothers usually know us better than anyone else. Sometimes a friend also knows us very well.

When somebody knows us, they know what we like, and we don't like. They know what makes us **happy** and what makes us unhappy.
