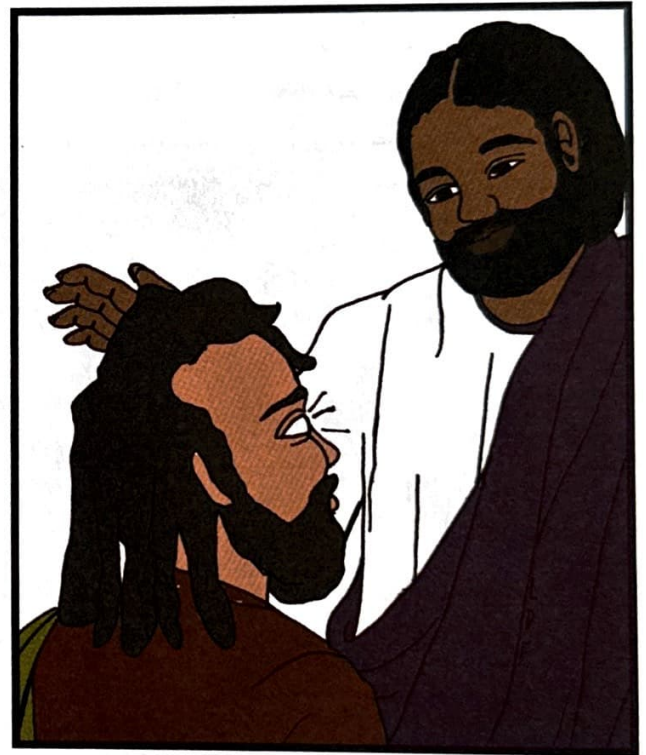


It's Time to Listen to Your Bible Lesson

Lesson 5

Luke 18:35-43

The story of Jesus healing a blind man in Jericho is told in Luke 18:35–43 of the Bible. The story is about a blind man named Bartimaeus who is sitting by the road begging for money and food when Jesus passes by. Bartimaeus the beggar calls out to Jesus, asking for kindness, and Jesus stops to help him. Jesus asked the blind man what he wanted Him to do. Bartimaeus said to Jesus, “Teacher, I want to see!” Jesus then healed him and he was able to see right away. Bartimaeus was filled with joy and happiness. He began to pray to Jesus and praised God for his **miracle**. The people who saw the healing also praised God for the miracle!
