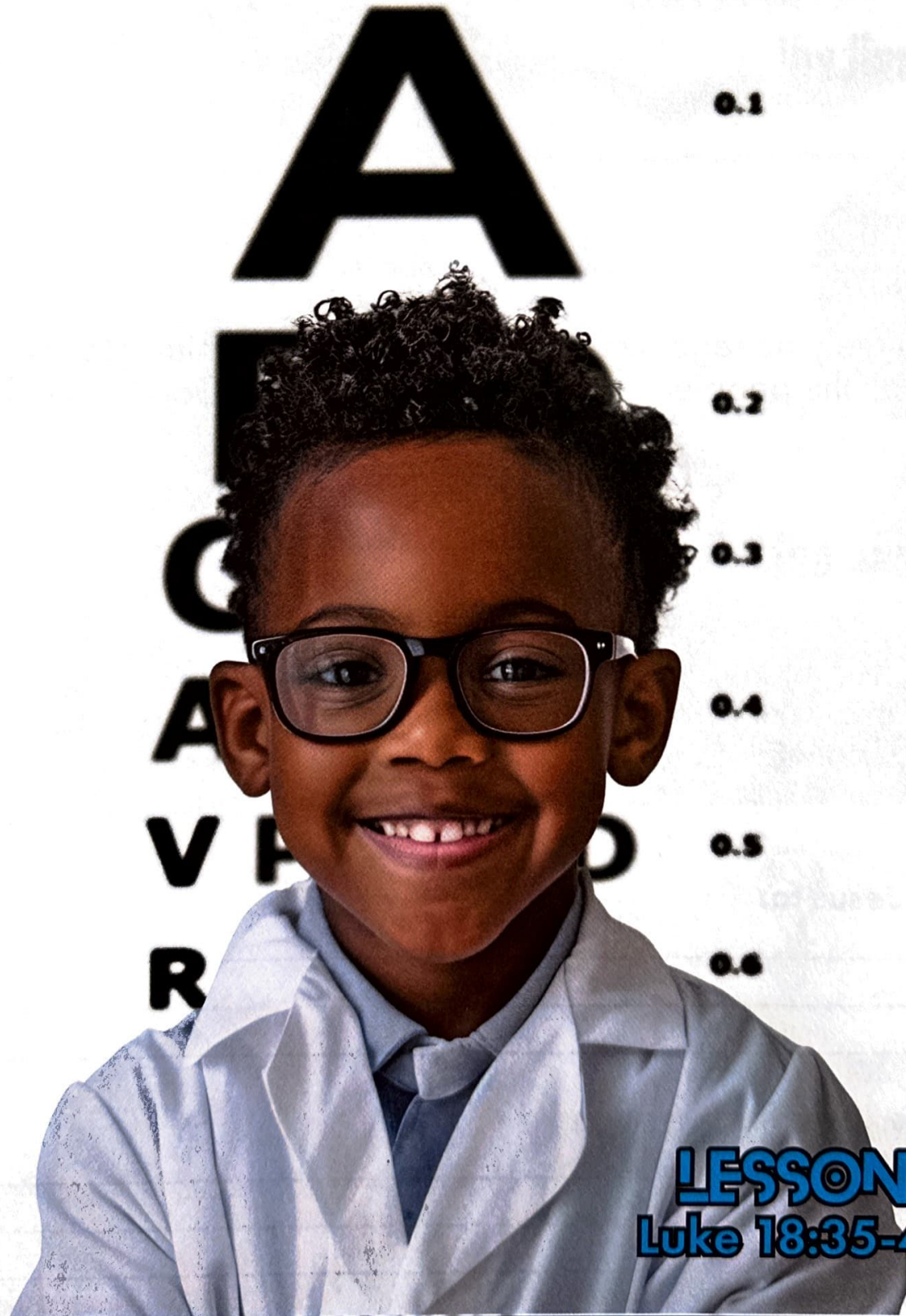


A Miracle in Jericho

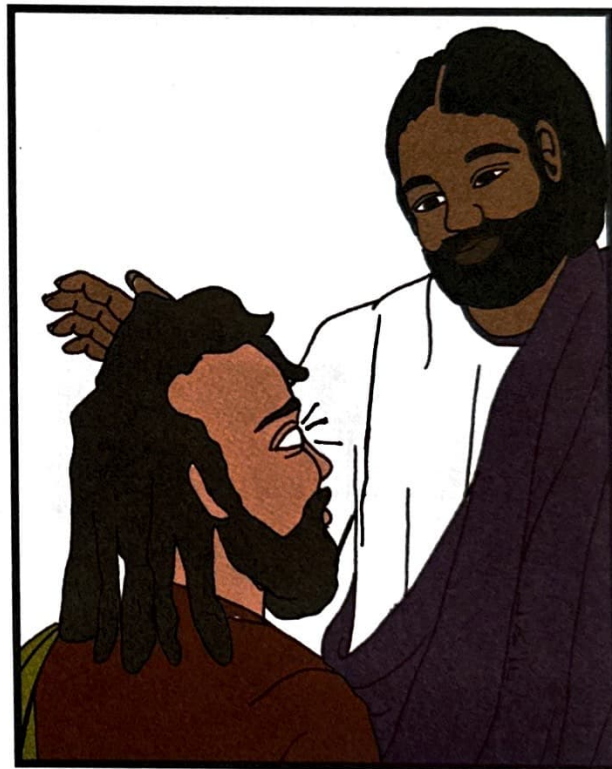

A Miracle in Jericho

The story of Jesus **healing** a blind man in Jericho is told in Luke 18:35–43 of the Bible. The story is about a blind man named Bartimaeus who is sitting by the road begging for money and food when Jesus passes by. Bartimaeus the beggar calls out to Jesus, asking for kindness, and Jesus stops to help him. Jesus asks the blind man what he wanted Him to do, and Bartimaeus said to Jesus, "Teacher, I want to see!" Jesus then healed him and he was able to see right away. Bartimaeus was filled with joy and happiness. He began to Jesus and **praised** God for his miracle. The people who saw the healing also praised God for the miracle!

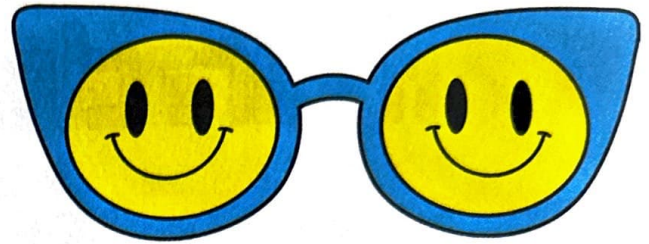
1. What city was Jesus passing through?
