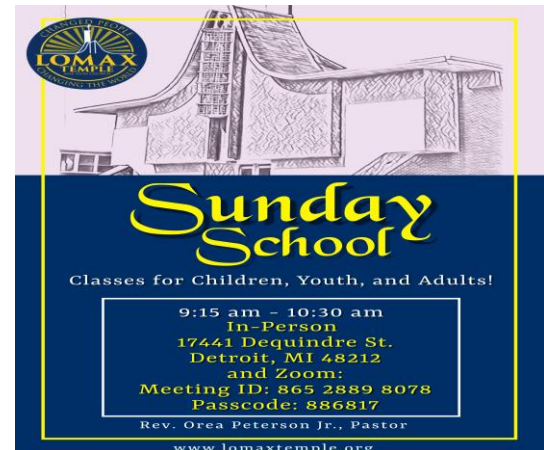


I hope that this email finds you well. First I want to say, Happy Women's History Month to all of you.

The 40 Days Prayer and Fasting Guide

The Mid-West Area will embark upon 40 Days of prayer and fasting, **March 5, 2025 – April 13, 2025**. This year we offer two fasting options for the Lenten season.

Option 1: 12 hours of juice, water, and broth from 6am to 6pm daily. At the end of the fast consider eating fish or chicken, no sweets, bread, or fried food. *(This should be a meager meal).*

Option 2: The Daniel Fast: No meat, no sweets, no bread, and no sugar drinks throughout the entire day. During this fast you may take in fruits, vegetables, nuts and whole grains.

Guidelines for a Daniel Fast: Suggested Foods to Eat

Whole Grains: Brown Rice, Oats, Barley, Legumes: Dried Beans, Pinto Beans, Split Peas, Lentils, Black Eyed Peas, etc. Fruits, Vegetables, Seeds, Nuts, Sprouts, Liquids: Water, 100% All-Natural Fruit Juices, and 100% All Natural Vegetable Juices.

Suggested Foods to Avoid

Meat, poultry, fish, all dairy products, white rice, fried foods, caffeine, carbonated beverages, foods containing preservatives or additives, refined sugar substitutes, white flour and all products using it, margarine, shortening, high fat products.
