Explain.
- 2. Read Gen. 22: 4-8; A) Should we practice any live sacrifices today? Explain.
 B) Explain the difference between polytheism; monotheism and tell which one relates to the Christian faith. C) Define Yahweh.
- 3. Read Gen. 22: 9-11; A) What does "proving one's faith through testing mean to you? B) Review Heb. 11:17-19 and relate it to this passage. C) In your opinion tell why Isaac did not resist!
- 4. Read Gen. 22: 12-14; A) God asks Abraham to demonstrate his trust through a willingness to offer his son to God. How can you show trust in God by giving or sustaining life? B) A sacrifice is an act of worship. Name three things you can sacrifice to worship God. C) Measure your level of obedience to God's leading in your life. How do we size up? What do we need to change in our lives to increase our obedience level?
