STAGE HAIR REQUIREMENTS

*Hair Style Requirements:

- ALL STUDENTS: Bun for the DURATION OF THE SHOW

*General Hair Supplies:

- Clear hair elastics or hair ties that match the color of your dancer's hair
- Bobby Pins and/or hair pins that match the color of your dancer's hair...you can't use too many!
- Bun Maker
- Hair Net that matches the color of your dancer's hair (REQUIRED FOR ALL STUDENTS WEARING A BUN)
- Hair Gel
- Hair Spray
- FINE BRISTLED BRUSH, regular brush, and comb

*Misc.:

- Fix hair when it is DIRTY, not when it is clean or wet
- Absolutely NO barrettes, clips, or colored hair accessories will be permitted.
- Regardless of age, please use hairspray to adhere all whispies on the sides, top and back of the head!
- Be sure to secure all hairpieces with SEVERAL bobby pins!

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STAGE MAKE-UP REQUIREMENTS

(Tippy Toes, Tutus & Bowties, Twinkle Tots, Happy Feet, Move 'n Groove, and Sparkle & Spunk)

- *Frost Beige Eyeshadow ("Champagne"—Cover Girl Single Eyeshadow as a suggestion) on entire eyelid up to the eyebrow
- *Smokey Grey Eyeshadow from middle of eyelid to end of eyebrow and up to the crease of the eye
- *Rose Colored Blush
- ***REQUIRED FOR ALL:** "Wild Berry" (#560) OR "Mauve Muse" (#585)—Cover Girl Outlast Lipstick Be sure that lips are dry and free of any greasy food/chap stick/lip gloss residue.

STAGE MAKE-UP REQUIREMENTS

(KiDance, Level-Up, Ultimate, all Acro classes, all Ballet classes, & all Company members)

- *Frost Beige Eyeshadow ("Champagne"—Cover Girl Single Eyeshadow as a suggestion) on entire eyelid up to the eyebrow
- *Smokey Grey Eyeshadow from middle of eyelid to end of eyebrow and up to the crease of the eye
- *Black Liquid Eyeliner on top of eyelid and create a small, thin "wing" out to the edge of the eyebrow
- *Black Pencil Eyeliner under the eyelid
- *2-3 Coats of Black Mascara
- *Rose Colored Blush
- *Powder entire face
- ***REQUIRED FOR ALL:** "Wild Berry" (#560) OR "Mauve Muse" (#585)—Cover Girl Outlast Lipstick Be sure that lips are dry and free of any greasy food/chap stick/lip gloss residue.
- *All Company students, Level-Up and Ultimates should wear a foundation base before applying make-up
- *Fake eyelashes for all company members

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COSTUME PREPARATION

***ALL ALTERATIONS DISCUSSED AT COSTUME DISTRIBUTION WEEK MUST BE COMPLETED BY PICTURE DAY!!**

- *Absolutely no safety pins or velcro are to be used in lieu of sewing
- *Be sure to label all of your dancer's dance shoes (label on the INSIDE OF THE SHOE, not on the sole of the shoe!)
- *Be sure to cut all tags out of your costumes
- *Iron all costumes that need it. Do NOT use anything more than the lowest heat setting on your iron and be sure to place an old pillowcase between your iron and the costume.
- *All costumes should be HUNG prior to and after they are worn

FINALE ATTIRE

As previously mentioned, all students will need the following attire for the finale of each recital:

- *RECITAL T-SHIRT (these will be handed out at the June 8th rehearsals)
- *PLAIN, BLACK "BOOTY SHORTS"-Girls (Please be sure that these are plain, with no logos...we have a limited amount of booty shorts on sale at the studio which will be available for purchase at the June 4th rehearsal)
- *PLAIN, BLACK ATHLETIC SHORTS-Boys (Please be sure that these are plain with no logos)
- *Tights-Girls (MUST BE THE REVOLUTION BRAND...we have a limited amount of tights n sale at the studio which will be available for purchase at the June 2nd rehearsal)
- *NUDE, SLIP-ON JAZZ SHOES-Sparkle & Spunk and Up (If your dancer is only in acro, please wear bare feet...if your dancer is only in Hip-Hop, please wear your hip-hop sneakers)
- *BALLET SHOES-All Pre-School Classes (Pink leather REVOLUTION BRAND for the girls, black for the boys)
- *Hair should remain in a bun for the finale

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TICKETS

The last day to purchase tickets at the \$20 price is Saturday, June 7th from 10:00am-2:00pm. Ticket sales will resume at the start of each recital at a price of \$25 (cash or check made payable to: Center Stage Dance Academy Pgh, LLC). No tickets will be sold on Sunday, June 8th or at any of the dress rehearsals.

JUNE 8TH REHEARSAL

To ensure a smooth-running dress rehearsal and recital, attendance is mandatory for all students participating in the recital(s).

****Please arrive TEN MINUTES EARLY as we want to START THE REHEARSAL at the designated times**

****If your student is in multiple recitals, they must attend ALL OF THE REHEARSALS associated with the recitals that they are in.**

****Students should wear NORMAL CLASS ATTIRE...this is NOT A DRESS REHEARSAL!**

****All students should bring water with them...those students staying for more than one rehearsal should bring snacks/lunch type foods (please do NOT bring anything containing nuts)**

DRESS REHEARSAL REMINDERS

***ONLY ONE PARENT/GUARDIAN MAY ATTEND THE DRESS REHEARSAL** (no family members, friends, or siblings are permitted)...please be sure to be wearing your MOTHER'S BADGE that you were given in your recital ticket packet!

*****VERY IMPORTANT:** Please be sure to CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT WITH YOUR DRESSING ROOM MONITOR immediately upon arriving to the dressing room and when leaving after the rehearsal.

*Students should NOT be wearing costumes to Carson Middle School. We don't want to jeopardize costumes getting wrinkled/ripped or costume pieces getting lost traveling to and from the middle school.

*Students should wear PANTS/SKIRT and a BUTTON DOWN/ZIPPERED SHIRT/JACKET with their TIGHTS ON...please be sure that it is something that does NOT need to be taken over the head as to ruin the student's hair and make-up.

*Hair should be in a slicked-back bun with appropriate make-up already APPLIED!!

*Upon arriving at Carson Middle School, please immediately dress your child in the costume of their FIRST NUMBER OF THE SHOW (please see the above RECITAL ORDER for this information).

*ABSOLUTELY NO MEN ARE PERMITTED IN THE FEMALE DRESSING ROOM and vice-versa!

***IMPORTANT:** Parents/guardians are only permitted to be in the dressing rooms to DRESS THEIR CHILD and must immediately report back to the auditorium upon finishing. Dressing Room Monitors will be present to watch over each room.

*Photography and Video are permitted during dress rehearsals but NOT DURING THE RECITALS); however, we cannot provide electrical outlets for charging purposes. For the safety of all performers and protection of all choreography, NO FOOTAGE OF ANY KIND (photos or videos) is permitted to be uploaded to ANY SOCIAL MEDIA OUTLET.

*NO FOOD or DRINK (other than water) is permitted in the Auditorium or Dressing Rooms. Students are permitted to have water in a clear container in their dressing room only. Please make sure that all students arrive to the dress rehearsal with a full tummy.

*Unlike previous years, students are NOT PERMITTED TO WATCH THE DRESS REHEARSAL.

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RECITAL REMINDERS

- *All mother's must be wearing their mother's badge to receive admission into the theater; otherwise, you will need to purchase a ticket
- *All patrons entering the auditorium will need a ticket to enter...regardless of when they arrive
- *****VERY IMPORTANT:** Please be sure to CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT WITH YOUR DRESSING ROOM MONITOR immediately upon arriving to the dressing room and when leaving after the recital.
- *Students should NOT be wearing costumes to Carson Middle School. We don't want to jeopardize costumes getting wrinkled/ripped or costume pieces getting lost traveling to and from the middle school.
- *Students should wear PANTS/SKIRT and a BUTTON DOWN/ZIPPERED SHIRT/JACKET with their TIGHTS ON...please be sure that it is something that does NOT need to be taken over the head as to ruin the student's hair and make-up.
- *Hair should be in a slicked-back bun/pigtails (depending on the class) with appropriate make-up already APPLIED!!
- *Upon arriving at Carson Middle School, please immediately dress your child in the costume of their FIRST NUMBER OF THE SHOW (please see the above RECITAL ORDER for this information).
- *ABSOLUTELY NO MEN ARE PERMITTED IN THE FEMALE DRESSING ROOM and vice-versa!
- ***IMPORTANT:** Parents/guardians are only permitted to be in the dressing rooms to DRESS THEIR CHILD and must immediately report back to the auditorium upon finishing. Dressing Room Monitors will be present to watch over each room.
- *Photography and Video are NOT PERMITTED DURING THE RECITALS
- *NO FOOD or DRINK (other than water) is permitted in the Auditorium or Dressing Rooms. Students are permitted to have water in a clear container in their dressing room only. Please make sure that all students arrive to the recital(s) with a full tummy.
- *Students are not permitted to watch the recital(s)...they must remain in their dressing room
- *Students performing in BOTH recitals on Saturday:
 - Students are asked to eat a healthy meal in between shows; however, costumes are not to be worn while eating
- *****IMPORTANT: NO ONE OTHER THAN THE PARENT/GUARDIAN WEARING THE MOTHER'S BADGE IS PERMITTED TO COME BACK TO THE DRESSING ROOM/STAGING AREA AT ANY TIME!!**

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MISC. REMINDERS

***VERY IMPORTANT:** NO ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES, OR DRUG PARAPHERNALIA IS PERMITTED IN OR ON THE GROUNDS OF CARSON MIDDLE SCHOOL. ANYONE NOT FOLLOWING THIS PROCEDURE WILL BE IMMEDIATELY REMOVED FROM SCHOOL GROUNDS AND DISMISSED PERMANENTLY FROM CENTER STAGE DANCE ACADEMY.

*For students that have one or NO number changes:

- There will be changing tents outside of the stage door so that you don't have to return back to the dressing room to change
- Please have the costume, costume pieces, and shoes in the changing tent at the start of the number prior to the change
- Remain calm and breathe! The calmer you are, the quicker the change will go! :)

*For kiddos that are in acro as well as other classes...rather than having to change tights, it is much easier to LAYER YOUR TIGHTS. First, put on your acro (stirrup) tights and then layer your convertible tights over top. It is much easier to take off and put on tights on top of tights rather than struggling to get tights on and off over sweaty legs!
