

About Our Program:

- 1. A Parent joins HIPPY when his or her child is 2–4 years old.
- 2. HIPPY is a 2 year program.
- 3. **Mom / Dad** is their child's first teacher.
- 4. The lessons take about 15 to 20 minutes daily.
- A trained Home Based Educator is responsible for issuing all HIPPY Program materials and role-playing lessons with the parent.
- 6. Home Visits are made weekly.
