ORDINANCE No. 2410-A BATTERY OR GAS POWERED SCOOTER, MINI MOTORCYCLES AND ATV'S

The Village of Ogden, hereby prohibits the use of battery or gas powered scooters, mini motorcycles and ATV's upon the streets of the Village of Ogden.

An Ordinance defining, establishing and prohibiting certain offenses and establishing penalties for violations thereof.

Be It Ordained by the President and board of Trustees of the Village of Ogden, Champaign County, Illinois:

- 1. SUBJECT: 2 to 4 wheel electric, battery or gas powered scooters, minimotorcycles or 4 wheeler vehicles designed to carry a person do not meet the standards to be registered in the State of Illinois.
- 2. RULING: The above mentioned vehicles shall not be operated on the streets of the Village of Ogden.
- 3. EXEMPTION: Mobile conveyance for persons with disabilities shall be exempt from this ordinance. Such persons shall operate on sidewalks where available and yield to pedestrians. Where there are no sidewalks the conveyance will operate along side of roadway.
- 4. ENFORCEMENT PROTOCOL: The following measures are authorized by the Village Board and the Ogden Police Department:
 - 1. Verbal warning of violation of Ordinance
 - 2. Class "C" Fine per occurrence
 - 3. Applicable State of Illinois vehicle code charge
 - 4. Guilty in court of law will result in fines and court costs
