

Mindoro Teachers' Mutual Aid System Inc. (MINMAS) was incorporated and obtained its juridical personality as issued by Securities and Exchange Commission on September 5, 2012. The primary purpose is to foster brotherhood, mutual help and provide financial assistance to beneficiary or beneficiaries of deceased members upon death of a member.

The Association holds its office, which is also its principal place of business, at 2nd Floor Panaligan Bldg. Marcelo H. Del Pilar St. San Vicente East, Calapan City, Oriental Mindoro. Further, the Association's License to Operate was granted by the Insurance Commission on February 26, 2016.

The annual meetings of the members shall be held at the principal office of the Association on the second Saturday of November of each year. The President shall render his annual report to the members regarding activities of the Association. The election of directors will likewise be held during this regular meeting.

Tax Exemption

As a non-stock, non-profit organization, the Association is exempt from the payment of income tax under Section 30c of the National Internal Revenue Code. However, the income of whatever kind and character of the Association from any of its properties, real or personal, or form any of its activities conducted for profit, regardless of the disposition made of such income, shall be subjected to tax.
