

First Baptist Community Profile

Location: First Baptist is located just outside of Mifflintown, Pennsylvania in Juniata County. Mifflintown is located approximately 45 miles northwest of Harrisburg and approximately 42 miles southeast of State College. Mifflintown is the Juniata County seat with many shops & restaurants. While most First Baptist attenders live in the county, some reside in the counties of Mifflin and Perry.

Economy: The average household income in Mifflintown is \$49,245 with a poverty rate of 22.02%. The median rental costs in recent years comes to \$609 per month, and the median house value is \$84,700. The median household income in Juniata County is \$53,879 with a poverty rate of 10%. In the whole county, the median rental costs from 2015-2019 comes to \$643 per month, and the median house value is \$148,900.

Population: With a 2020 population of 909, Mifflintown is the 625th [largest city in Pennsylvania](#) and the 10715th [largest city in the United States](#). Mifflintown is currently declining at a rate of -0.11% annually and its population has decreased by -2.88% since the most recent census, which recorded a population of 936 in 2010. In 2020, the population of Juniata County was 23,509 which was down from 24,636 in 2010.

Demographics: According to the most recent census, the racial composition of Mifflintown was: White: 90.87%, Other race: 7.68%, Black or African American: 0.73%, Two or more races: 0.73%, Native American: 0.00%, Asian: 0.00%, and Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander: 0.00% (these numbers are consistent county-wide).

Climate/Weather: Juniata County, Pennsylvania gets 42 inches of rain and 29 inches of snow per year. On average, there are 195 sunny days per year, and Juniata County gets some kind of precipitation (at least .01 inches on the ground to measure), on average, 122 days per year. The July high averages around 84 degrees and the January low at 20 degrees.

Crime: Crime is ranked on a scale of 1 (low crime) to 100 (high crime). Juniata Counties violent crime is 8.7 (the US average is 22.7) and property crime is 13.6 (the US average is 35.4).
