## RULES - (Teen and Queen Divisions)

### \*\*\*Teen & Queen - Private Interview 5 mins – Aerobic Wear - Evening Gown

1. A contestant must be a resident of Crawford County one year prior to pageant.
2. A queen contestant must be 18 years of age day of pageant.
3. A teen contestant must be 14 years of age day of pageant.
4. If your birthday falls within 7 days of the pageant, you may enter the teen/queen.
5. A current or past CCFA Teen/Queen title holder is not eligible to participate.
6. Contestant must be a single female, never have been married or had a marriage annulled, contestant can never have been, be pregnant or become pregnant during reign.
7. Must be a US Citizen and never have been convicted of a felony offense.
8. If chosen as winner, you agree to represent CCFA and compete for the title of Miss AR State Fair Teen/Queen. Pageant will be held in Little Rock. Information will be provided to winner by pageant director. You must be accompanied by a chaperone always during the event of the fair and at any personal appearances when you are wearing crown if under 18. (When making appearances, no jeans are permitted unless approved by director.) Chaperone should be a parent, adult family member over the age of 21. Winner will be responsible for her own transportation to/from State Fair. If unable to attend, title will be removed, all scholarships and gifts forfeited, and 1<sup>st</sup> Runner Up will be crowned the new queen and attend state fair to compete for the title of Arkansas State Fair Queen.
9. If for any reason your permanent residence should change within your reign, privileges connected with the said title shall also be handed down to the first runner up.
10. In case of marriage, pregnancy, living with a man, or any reason the winner is unable to fulfill her obligations as the reigning title holder, or any which the pageant director deems unacceptable of a winner, the title holder will relinquish the title IMMEDIATELY, and all privileges connected with the said title, together with ALL prizes awarded to her, and runner up shall be awarded all prizes as if she were chosen winner (crown, sash, scholarship). She shall be succeeded by the next eligible contestant.
11. Entrant agrees to abide by all rules of the District and State contests now in effect or as hereafter announced.
12. Illegal drugs, alcohol and smoking will not be tolerated. If you have been arrested or charged with drugs or alcohol, or been treated for either, you will not be eligible to participate.
13. **The winner will be expected to represent the CCFA to gain as much exposure as possible - visit schools, local civic groups, festivals, parades, etc. Winner will submit a list of all appearances to director before end of reign. Must make 12 or more appearances for the year. Winner will also return the following year to crown her successor and participate in the Annual Fair Parade and Fair.**
14. **Scholarships will not be paid until one full semester has been completed by title holder and a request letter from winner is submitted to director.** UAFS Scholarship – rules are set by UAFS and you must be a full time student to receive the scholarship, maintain the GPA required, and follow any other rules set by UAFS.
15. Dressing room will be provided for contestant, please arrive 45 minutes early.
16. Only contestant will be admitted free of charge to fairgrounds. Pass will be given at rehearsal.
17. **Due to limited space: CONTESTANTS ONLY BACKSTAGE!**
18. You must do your own hair and makeup for pageant, unless you have an outside appt. prior to pageant starting time.
19. **IF YOU CURRENTLY HOLD A TITLE WITH A NATIONAL PAGEANT – You must check with your current director to see if you are eligible to compete.**
20. **Aerobic wear will replace sportswear for teens and swimsuit for queen. Aerobic wear consists of sports bra and shorty shorts (spandex).**
21. Interview times will be emailed – you will arrive 10 minutes before your scheduled interview time in your interview attire (no jeans). Interviews will be held at the pageant building.
22. **ALL CONTESTANTS ARE REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ANNUAL FAIR PARADE! You must furnish your own vehicle and signage. Line up begins on Church Street, turn by the Dairy Dip.**

TEEN & MISS: All contestants other than newly crowned county fair pageant winner are eligible for the district fair which is the Arkansas Oklahoma State Fair Pageant. Same divisions apply. Entry form is online at [www.arkansasoklahomafair.com](http://www.arkansasoklahomafair.com) - Pageant is held on Oct. 3rd at the Expo Center at Kay Rodgers Park in Fort Smith.

## RULES (Youth Divisions)

Tiny Tot (0-23 mo) Pageant Dress Only  
Tiny Princess (2-4) Pageant Dress Only  
Princess (5-6) Casual Wear & Pageant Dress  
Jr Princess (7-8) Casual Wear & Pageant Dress  
Little Miss (9-10) Casual Wear & Pageant Dress  
Jr Miss (11-13) Casual Wear & Pageant Dress

1. A winner of a title may not compete again in the same division in which she holds a title, you must wait until you move up into the next age group.
2. Judges decisions are final. Score sheets will not be handed out after pageant.
3. If for any reason the winner is unable to fulfill her obligations, or for any reason which the pageant director deems unacceptable, they will relinquish their title immediately, and all privileges and prizes.
4. If for any reason, your permanent residence should change within your reign, privileges connected with the said title shall also be handed down to the first runner up.
5. Display of poor sportsmanship and/or unbecoming conduct, interference or disturbance, behavioral problem created by a contestant, parent, guardian, or relative could result in disqualification of the contestant not only from this year's contest, but also from future contests. THIS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED!
6. Only contestant will be admitted into fairgrounds free of charge with pass. Pass will be given out at rehearsal.
7. Winner is required to attend next year's pageant and crown new winner and participate in the Annual Fair Parade.
8. Dressing room will be provided for contestant. Please arrive 45 minutes early.
9. **ONE PERSON PER CONTESTANT BACK STAGE**, so do not get upset if you are asked to leave. If person is asked more than once to leave, your contestant will not participate in pageant! **YOU MUST HAVE ARMBAND ON TO ENTER BACKSTAGE AREA!**
10. NO HAIRDRESSERS OR MAKEUP ARTIST ALLOWED BACKSTAGE. Hair/makeup must be done before arriving or by parent only!!!! NO EXCEPTIONS!
11. **ALL CONTESTANTS ARE REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ANNUAL FAIR PARADE! You must furnish your own vehicle and signage. Line up begins on Church Street – turn beside the Dairy Dip.**
