COMMERCIAL BUILDING RULES:

1. Inside or outside- 10x10 space is \$60. Electrical outlets are provided. Multiple extension cords and outlets will be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Extension cords must be kept to the minimal length necessary to reach the booth. It is suggested that cords be secured with tape to the floor.

2. Tables, display equipment, and backdrops must be furnished by the vendor. All tables must be skirted or covered.

3. Booth must be reserved and paid for no later than August 1, 2023. After that date, the space will be \$75. Booths are assigned on a first come-first serve basis.
4. Organization participation in a donation drawing must have a booth, however drawing must be held on the last day of CCFA.
5. No obscene, lewd, or sexually explicit displays will be allowed.
6. No smoking or vaping is allowed inside the commercial building. No Alcohol is allowed on the property of the Crawford County Fair.
7. Supt. Decision are final when question arise about the appropriateness of a booth.
8. Vendors are responsible for keeping their area clean and free of trash. Please do not place cardboard boxes in trash cans.
9. Vendors are not allowed to solicit outside of booths or on fairgrounds.
10. Each vendor will receive 2 gate bands for entry. Additional gate bands may be purchased at the gate.
11. Only one (1) booth of a type will be allowed, Example: Mary Kay, Scentsy, Paparazzi, etc.
