TEXT BACKGROUND

Peter Prange (b. 1972) wrote this hymn in the fall of 1999. While preparing for the observation of St. Michael and All Angels at the parish in Jacksonville, Florida, where he was pastor, Prange was not satisfied with the existing hymns for this occasion in the church year. He explains, “I could find no existing hymn’ that properly surveyed the scriptural truths of this important festival (not even a mention of St. Michael!), so I decided to write one myself.” The hymn was originally sung to the tune SIEH, HIER BIN ICH (LSB 353)
