「看哪,我今日將生與福,死與禍,陳明在你面前。吩咐你愛耶和華-你的上帝,遵行他的道,謹守他的誡命、律例、典章,使你可以存活,人數增多,耶和華-你上帝就必在你所要進去得為業的地上賜福與你。倘若你心裏偏離,不肯聽從,卻被勾引去敬拜事奉別神,我今日明明告訴你們,你們必要滅亡;在你過約旦河、進去得為業的地上,你的日子必不長久。我今日呼天喚地向你作見證;我將生死禍福陳明在你面前,所以你要揀選生命,使你和你的後裔都得存活;且愛耶和華-你的上帝,聽從他的話,專靠他;因為他是你的生命,你的日子長久也在乎他。這樣,你就可以在耶和華向你列祖亞伯拉罕、以撒、雅各起誓應許所賜的地上居住。」

哥林多前書 3:1-9

弟兄們,我從前對你們說話,不能把你們當作屬靈的,只得把你們當作屬肉體,在基督裏為嬰孩的。我是用奶餵你們,沒有用飯餵你們。那時你們不能吃,就是如今還是不能。你們仍是

屬肉體的,因為在你們中間有嫉妒、紛爭,這豈不是屬乎肉體、照著世人的樣子行嗎?有說:「我是屬保羅的」;有說:「我是屬亞波羅的。」這豈不是你們和世人一樣嗎?亞波羅算甚麼?保羅算甚麼?無非是執事,照主所賜給他們各人的,引導你們相信。我栽種了,亞波羅澆灌了,惟有上帝叫他生長。可見栽種的,算不得甚麼,澆灌的,也算不得甚麼;只在那叫他生長的上帝。栽種的和澆灌的,都是一樣,但將來各人要照自己的工夫得自己的賞賜。因為我們是與上帝同工的;你們是上帝所耕種的田地,所建造的房屋。

馬太福音5:21-37

「你們聽見有吩咐古人的話,說:『不可殺人』;又說:『凡 殺人的難免受審判。』只是我告訴你們,凡向弟兄動怒的,難 免受審斷;凡罵弟兄是拉加的,難免公會的審斷;凡罵弟兄是 魔利的, 難免地獄的火。所以, 你在祭壇上獻禮物的時候, 若 想起弟兄向你懷怨,就把禮物留在壇前,先去同弟兄和好,然 後來獻禮物。你同告你的對頭還在路上,就趕緊與他和息,恐 怕他把你送給審判官,審判官交付衙役,你就下在監裏了。我 實在告訴你,若有一文錢沒有還清,你斷不能從那裏出來。」 「你們聽見有話說:『不可姦淫。』只是我告訴你們,凡看見 婦女就動淫念的,這人心裏已經與她犯姦淫了。若是你的右眼 叫你跌倒,就剜出來丟掉,寧可失去百體中的一體,不叫全身 丢在地獄裏。若是右手叫你跌倒,就砍下來丟掉,寧可失去百 體中的一體,不叫全身下入地獄。」「又有話說:『人若休 妻,就當給她休書。』只是我告訴你們,凡休妻的,若不是為 淫亂的緣故,就是叫她作淫婦了;人若娶這被休的婦人,也是 犯姦淫了。」「你們又聽見有吩咐古人的話,說:『不可背誓, 所起的誓總要向主謹守。』只是我告訴你們,甚麼誓都不可起。 不可指著天起誓,因為天是上帝的座位;不可指著地起誓,因 為地是他的腳凳;也不可指著耶路撒冷起誓,因為耶路撒冷是 大君的京城;又不可指著你的頭起誓,因為你不能使一根頭髮 變黑變白了。你們的話,是,就說是;不是,就說不是;若再 多說就是出於那惡者。」

Deuteronomy 30:15-20

Moses said to all Israel the words which the Lord commanded him, "See, I have set before you today life and prosperity, death and adversity. If you obey the commandments of the LORD your God that I am commanding you today, by loving the LORD your God, walking in his ways, and observing his commandments, decrees, and ordinances, then you shall live and become numerous, and the LORD your God will bless you in the land that you are entering to possess. But if your heart turns away and you do not hear, but are led astray to bow down to other gods and serve them, I declare to you today that you shall perish; you shall not live long in the land that you are crossing the Jordan to enter and possess. I call heaven and earth to witness against you today that I have set before you life and death, blessings and curses. Choose life so that you and your descendants may live, loving the LORD your God, obeying him, and holding fast to him; for that means life to you and length of days, so that you may live in the land that the LORD swore to give to your ancestors, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob."

Psalm 119:1-8

1 Happy are they whose way is blameless, * who walk in the law of the LORD! 2 Happy are they who observe his decrees * and seek him with all their hearts! 3 Who never do any wrong, * but always walk in his ways. 4 You laid down your commandments, * that we should fully keep them. 5 Oh, that my ways were made so direct * that I might keep your statutes! 6 Then I should not be put to shame, * when I regard all your commandments. 7 I will thank you with an unfeigned heart, * when I have learned your righteous judgments. 8 I will keep your statutes; * do not utterly forsake me.

1 Corinthians 3:1-9

Brothers and sisters, I could not speak to you as spiritual people, but rather as people of the flesh, as infants in Christ. I fed you with milk, not solid food, for you were not ready for solid food. Even now you are still not

ready, for you are still of the flesh. For as long as there is jealousy and quarreling among you, are you not of the flesh, and behaving according to human inclinations? For when one says, "I belong to Paul," and another, "I belong to Apollos," are you not merely human?

What then is Apollos? What is Paul? Servants through whom you came to believe, as the Lord assigned to each. I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth. So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth. The one who plants and the one who waters have a common purpose, and each will receive wages according to the labor of each. For we are God's servants, working together; you are God's field, God's building.

Matthew 5:21-37

Jesus said, "You have heard that it was said to those of ancient times, 'You shall not murder'; and `whoever murders shall be liable to judgment.' But I say to you that if you are angry with a brother or sister, you will be liable to judgment; and if you insult a brother or sister, you will be liable to the council; and if you say, 'You fool,' you will be liable to the hell of fire. So when you are offering your gift at the altar, if you remember that your brother or sister has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar and go; first be reconciled to your brother or sister, and then come and offer your gift. Come to terms quickly with your accuser while you are on the way to court with him, or your accuser may hand you over to the judge, and the judge to the guard, and you will be thrown into prison. Truly I tell you, you will never get out until you have paid the last penny.

"You have heard that it was said, 'You shall not commit adultery.' But I say to you that everyone who looks at a woman with lust has already committed adultery with her in his heart. If your right eye causes you to sin, tear it out and throw it away; it is better for you to lose one of your members than for your whole body to be thrown into hell. And if your right hand causes you to sin, cut it off and throw it away; it is better for you to lose one of your members than for your whole body to go into hell.

"It was also said, `Whoever divorces his wife, let him give her a certificate of divorce.' But I say to you that anyone who divorces his wife, except on the ground of unchastity, causes her to commit adultery; and whoever marries a divorced woman commits adultery.

"Again, you have heard that it was said to those of ancient times, `You shall not swear falsely, but carry out the vows you have made to the Lord.' But I say to you, Do not swear at all, either by heaven, for it is the throne of God, or by the earth, for it is his footstool, or by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King. And do not swear by your head, for you cannot make one hair white or black. Let your word be `Yes, Yes' or `No, No'; anything more than this comes from the evil one.
