

Golf Tournament

Organize a golf tournament in your community. With the help of a local golf pro or enthusiast, you can capture the interest of your local golfing community.

- Recruit the help of a local golf pro or hobbyist from the local golf club or your community.
- Establish the format and rules of the tournament.
- Contact leagues and other clubs and arrange for pre-tournament registration.
- Arrange for trophies and merchandise. Ask to see if a donor would insure a hole in one, or would underwrite the cost of tournament golf caps or visors.
- Advise participants of tee-off times and make certain that every participant is registered before they begin to play.
- Create a Facebook event and group to send reminders and keep everyone excited about the event. Facebook is also a great tool to get the word out about the tournament and invite participants. You may post photos of the awards being offered and of participants practicing for the event.
- Arrange for a standings board to be kept up-to-date in the club house.
- Hold a small award ceremony after the tournament to award prizes. Invite participants, donors, and volunteers.
- You may choose to sponsor an informal golf tournament, such as a “tin can” golf tournament. Holes are coffee cans placed in the ground or tires hanging from trees, and participants are only allowed one club. This tournament can be held in a large backyard or a field.
