World Meeting of Families Dublin, August 2018: Pope Francis has confirmed he will be attending Dublin on 25th & 26th August Those who have booked to travel on the 3rd bus to the WMOF event should ensure payment reaches the parish office no later than Friday 27th April. Seats will be re-allocated if not paid for by that date. We have provisionally booked a smaller bus and have 33 seats remaining. This is the final bus travelling from the local area on August 26th. No further bookings will be taken after Friday 27th April. Seats will be allocated on a first come firsts served basis.

Set Top Boxes: Some parishioners who ordered and received a set top box (Kodi or Roku) may not be receiving the church webcam now. This is a technical issue – beyond the control of the parish. We are informed that the authorities who deal with the copyright issues are 'freezing' these boxes out apparently because people in Britain and elsewhere were illegally downloading films – to give one example. MCN MEDIA who provide our webcam streaming also have a box which is specifically geared to receive the church stream. MCN are offering it to the parish for £60 – at a reduced price – if we get enough orders. If you are interested, ring the Parish office – No money needed yet – just place an order.
