#### The Society Of St. Vincent De Paul

Following on from the controversy in regard to the St. Vincent de Paul Society and the 8<sup>th</sup> Amendment referendum the Society has issued the following statement:

St. Vincent de Paul Wishes to clarify that it embraces the Church's teaching and upholds Gospel values. Our rule states that Vincentians are committed to supporting life from conception to its natural earthly end. We endorse the comments made last week by General President of SVP, Renato Lima de Oilveira, when he described the charity as a 'Christian organisation that defends the right to life'. Our General President also commented – 'We reaffirm our position of the defence of life, not only as a Christian duty but, above all, as an attitude to the sacredness of the life of the human being. We defend every stage of life and all the difficulties that it may encounter. We rejet all arguments, threats and mechanisms that are contrary to life! We will not build a just society, of peace and prosperity, by admitting the right to kill human beings, especially the most vulnerable and innocent of them'
