Tickets were booked and paid for by the Parish office in good faith – we have taken a small number of calls this week – we understand and respect your point of view, but would ask that you respect Parish staff and understand that we based our information on the advice given at the time. All ticket proceeds have been paid to the WMOF and buses have also been paid for – the parish are not making any profit from the event, we facilitated the organising of the tickets etc to try and assist parishioners as best we could. As we previously stated, if you no longer wish to attend this historic event, please let us know and we will try to sell your ticket for you.
