How You Have Helped Trócaire: The war in Syria is now in its eighth year and continues to have devastating impacts. The total number of humanitarian assistance in Syria has reached 13.5 million, approximately 6.5 million of whom are internally displaced. Over the last three years, Trócaire have directly helped 347,000 people in Syria nearby Lebanon. In addition, through our Caritas partners, we have aided 103,900 refugees entering Europe over the past years.
