Smithmoor Range of Carpenter, Wyoming is home to two shooting ranges. The East Smithmoor Range has a heated and insulated shooting house from which the competitors fire from that allows range use even in the worst of the winter. This range is 200 yards long and has a capacity of 30 competitors. We run mostly .22 BPCRA silhouette events here and host a "Winter Season" from November through April. At the West Smithmoor Range we have a NRA 500 meter BPCR silhouette range that holds up to 24 BPCR shooters or 48 .22 shooters.. We have room and plans to expand this range to accommodate more competitors. The west range also has a heated and insulated clubhouse along with an 80 foot covered, concrete firing line. We are local farmers and businessmen and we built these ranges with a lot of generous support to have a place to hold local, state, and regional BPCR shooting matches. Our facility fills a much needed role as increased urbanization has closed many ranges and left shooters with a lack of places to compete. Currently we have shooters come on a regular basis from all over Colorado and Wyoming. Our large matches will draw shooters from as far away as Canada, as well as most of the western states.

We have just two matches lined up this year and would like to extend an invitation to you to help support them. Any donation you are able to give is greatly appreciated! We value our sponsors tremendously and do everything in our power to publicize your products, your business, and your generosity.

We are in the middle of our 6th season of .22 BPCRA and have developed quite a loyal following of shooters. We are still getting new shooters and we may have to look at extending our .22 range to accommodate everyone. So far it has worked out that we have had enough room, but we have been at maximum capacity several times. A good problem to have! Our .22 Winter season culminates with a series championship held in April. The season finale match is always a full house. We usually award belt buckles to the top shooters in each class and a special prize to our top season shooters.

For the fourth year, we are hosting the Smithmoor BPCR Cup and this year we are adding the Rocky Mountain Regional .22 Championship to the weekend. Due to some changes and trying to outguess the weather, we have moved our matches to July. We will have a two day 40 shot BPCR match for the Smithmoor Cup, July 16-17th and a two day 40 shot .22 BPCRA match, July 18-19th. Last year we had a full house with a very successful match that we are hoping to duplicate again this year.
