

San Diego City Nursing Students' Association Honors Program

Students who demonstrate commitment to the SDCC NSA organization will be recognized at the pinning ceremony with an NSA Honors cord and a certificate of achievement recognizing distinguished service.

Qualifications for NSA Honors will be based on a points system and will depend on the student's attendance and involvement in NSA events. Students must be members of NSNA to qualify.

Traditional track 2-year students will require 30 NSA points to receive the accolade.

LVN-track students will require 20 NSA points to receive the accolade.

*2nd year students in the program's inaugural year will require 20 NSA points to receive the accolade.

Points will be assigned as follows:

- Attending an NSA meeting 1 pt
- Leading a board-approved NSA event 3 pts
- 1 year of satisfactory NSA committee membership 4 pts
 - "Satisfactory" as determined by committee director
- Volunteering at a Community Health event 1 pt per hour
- Attend a fundraising event 1 pt
- Attending a Fellowship event 1 pt
- Donating a uniform piece 1 pt
- Attending a faculty meeting 1pt
 - Attendance must be arranged in advance through NSA. Space is limited.
- Donating 10 food pantry items 1pt
 - Maximum 1 pt per semester
- Other student activities may be designated points at the discretion of the Board of Directors.

All NSA events eligible for points will have an attendance designee who will record and report eligible hours. Membership Director will keep track of points and eligibility for NSA Honors.
