The fall semester began in August and will continue into October for most of the students but some will not finish until November. Rainy season begins in May and usually ends in October. This year so far has been one of unusually strong storms. One of our young ladies said she had never seen it rain so hard and so much in Guatemala. Because of the mountainous nature of Guatemala, with heavy rains come mudslides which destroy highways. At times villages of several thousand people are submerged under 20 ft of mud killing everyone.

In an effort to give you more insight into the individual lives of the girls, we asked several of them to tell you about themselves. Following are their stories with very little editing.

#### Catty

Catty graduated in December last year with a university degree in Industrial Psychology (Human Resources). As many have discovered, everyone wants to hire someone with experience, and she had none.

However, her God is greater than all of that! He provide employment for her at the church that we all attended when we were at Prince of Peace. It is a very large church with two campuses, their doctrine is sound and they set a very high standard for whatever they do. We were so excited and grateful to God when Catty gave us the news. God put Dr. Jim and Miss Kay who have made me feel part of their family, and feel that I belong. A year and a half ago, our life changed, so much that we did not know how to handle the situation. We are never prepared to lose a loved one; losing our sister in January 2021, was a very hard blow for both of us, we were so locked in our grief that we did not know how to handle the loss. We had sunk so deep and so deep that sometimes we thought we were not going to get out of it.

However God surrounded us with wonderful people who have supported us during this process, using different means and channels that gave us their unconditional love and reminded us of the great love that God has for each one of us.



In the middle of this hard process, Prince of Peace was the place that God used to heal us and re-center us with ourselves, so we can say that Prince of Peace transforms lives, because through the smiles of the girls we can see the beauty of God.

Returning to POP during this time of loss also allowed us to relive happy moments that we shared with our sister Marjorie who is in the presence of God. As she grew up in Prince of Peace, when we think of her we only see a kind girl, with a big heart and able to share with others the little she had, an extraordinary mother and an exemplary daughter, friend, and sister.

It has been a privilege to belong to Prince of Peace, which will always be our home. When we think of Principe de Paz, we can only think that it is and will continue to be our home, "our house". Not only because we grew up there, but because we have great memories, teachings, and life lessons.
