MAKE A GREAT DAY!!

FROM THE PRESIDENT

Ingredients:

2 to 3 Fresh or Frozen Strawberries (muddled if you do not use blender)
1 to 1 1/2 Cups Lemonade (with sugar)
1.5 oz Vodka (or more, if desired)
2 or 3 Drops of Bitters
A Generous Splash of Club Soda
1/2 Cup Crushed Ice
Granulated Sugar (if desired)

It is best to use a blender. I use one of those little bullet blenders for smoothies.

Add the strawberries, lemonade, Vodka, ice, and Bitters to the container. Blend until the ice is finely chipped. It should take no more than one minute. Pour contents into a cocktail glass or a martini glass. Add the splash of soda and stir.

It should have a little foam on top of the liquid.

Hints:

For a little taste of additional sweetness, moisten the rim of the glass and dip the rim in the granulated sugar. This also makes it more appealing.

If using fresh strawberries, cut the tops off and slice the berries; add a little sugar; refrigerate overnight.

For more generous drink portions, just increase the ingredients to your liking.

FROM KENTUCKY - VICKY JONES

Hello State Presidents,



The IC Convention Committee hopes that you and your state members are planning to come to IC Convention in Louisville Kentucky. We want to put all of your minds at ease, and let you know that we are dedicated to making sure that you are safe during your stay. The state of Kentucky does have a mask mandate, therefore you are required to wear a mask throughout the convention. The hotel is following CDC guidelines of social distancing. All meeting rooms will be preset for the entire convention in rounds. Since the hotel is following these social distancing guidelines, that means that there will only be 4 people at each round table instead of the normal 10 people per table. After each event/meeting, the room will be cleared so the hotel staff can complete their sanitation requirements.

The hotel is also making sure that everyone is safe within their sleeping rooms. When someone checks out of the room, the room is thoroughly sanitized and clean, and no one can check into that particular room for two days.

Upon arriving and registering at IC Convention, you will be required to fill out a Covid form letting us know information about you. We will also be taking temperatures upon entering every event/meeting. Anyone who has a temperature of 100.4 or greater will be asked to leave and return to their sleeping room. If this happens to be a food event, then we will make arrangements that your food will be brought to you.

Most of us have been very cautious since the Covid pandemic, but feel very comfortable about attending IC Convention. The Convention Committee and the IC Board have gone out of their way to make sure everyone is safe.

We also want to convey, that the state of Kentucky has been meticulous, and has worked hard to keep COVID related positivity rates under control. Since January, with mass vaccinations taking place, COVID cases in Kentucky has dropped tremendously.

I look forward to seeing all of you in Nashville the end of October. I hope everyone is staying well and getting their vaccines.




FROM THE END OF ONE BEGINNING TO THE BEGINNING OF ANOTHER

Take this opportunity to thank God for His blessing of this new beginning. Take the new challenge to serve others in only the ways that ESA'ers can!




SERC PARLIAMENTARIAN
