Would you believe it goes this way with pastors, too? It's quite easy to get sucked into busyness to the point that we miss what good is going on around and within us. Last week, I slowed myself down enough to take a moment for spending time on the phone with Assistant to the Bishop Connie Schmucker. It was wonderful to catch up and to reconnect. While we were on the phone together, Connie and I spoke of what good things God is doing at JOY Lutheran Church.

As we spoke of what Connie saw, it helped me to see more and more how God is doing wonderful things through this faithful community because this congregation has a heart turned towards Jesus.

Because JOY has a heart turned towards Jesus:

- We already have Day Camp 2022 in the works, scheduled for June 28th-July 1st.
- We are meeting Mission Support and are proposing an increase of \$1,000.
- We are hosting blood drives every 60 days+/-.
- We are giving through JOY to Daily Bread, God's Pantry, and Bread of Life.
- We have helped people to put food on their tables and to keep a roof over their heads.
- We have seen that seminarians have books in the U.S. and in India.
- We have put prayer shawls around shoulders and quilts on laps.
- Through us, Jesus is doing... fill in this blank with what you see__.

Because JOY has a heart turned towards Jesus, if we slow ourselves down a bit, we will see how our love of Jesus comes first, resulting in loving acts of service being given for others, and how God is actively doing this through you. It's a beautiful thing to see, yet we must slow down to see it.

Needs for DAILY BREAD Health/Hygiene Kits: miscellaneous items needed, i.e., sample/motel size toiletries (shampoo, soap, conditioner, lotions), deodorant, toothpaste & tooth brushes, shaving cream, hair combs and brushes for women & men, razors, sanitary pads, wash cloths, chapstick or lip balm, bug spray and sunscreen. Also needed, are laundry pods for laundry services & for clients.

- Continue to maintain the grounds including mowing the grass.


