

Community Notice

Spring is in the air and as a result the VIP (Volunteers in Prevention) inspections will begin soon. We are reaching out to you to ask for volunteers to help with this effort.

What is involved?

You will receive training on what to look for appropriate fire standards when inspecting each lot.

When it is time to begin the first inspections, you will be contacted and assigned an inspection area within Forest Meadows Owners Association (FMOA).

You will walk, review, and record your findings on each lot within your area. You will decide if the property passes inspection or needs additional attention to comply with appropriate fire standards. FMOA will generate and mail letters to those properties that need work and owners will be given a deadline to complete the required work.

Within 30-45 days you will be asked to reinspect those lots that did not pass the initial inspection. You will walk, review, and record your findings on each of these lots within your area.

The Fire Mitigation Committee intends to make fire mitigation a year-round effort. As the committee develops and rolls out the program and identifies the need for additional inspections, you may be asked to help. However, the actual plan for this has not yet been formalized.

This is an important step in our Community fire mitigation and thus we require as many volunteers as possible to make the task manageable. We hope you will seriously consider volunteering for this important issue.
