but a crushed spirit dries up the bones.

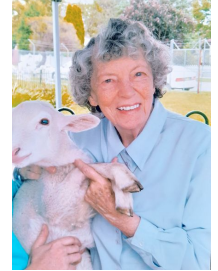
## Learn to see the good

# Being Faithful in what and who you have been given

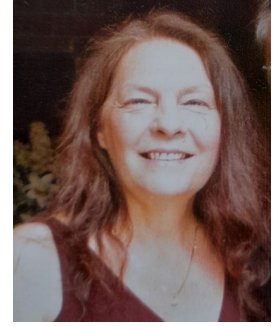
