



COVID-19 UPDATE

Hello Friends of The Well,

We want to give you an update and let you know where we stand in the reopening process. We will continue to meet ONLINE, AND in-person, this Sunday.

According to the governor’s directive, we are still in Phase 1: “PLACES OF WORSHIP can become operational on or after April 26, 2020...where strict physical distancing protocols can be maintained between non-household members.” His statement said that if more than 10 people will be gathering, then appropriate physical distancing practices should be implemented.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

At The Well, we will provide two Sunday worship experiences at 9:15am and 11:00am (via livestream at www.well.church and) in-person with rows of chairs six feet apart to aid in appropriate spacing, but we will not be policing people. We will provide ample hand sanitizer stations and will be disinfecting surfaces in between services and uses. In order to be diligent and cautious, we will be serving coffee, rather than having it self-serve, as we usually do.

Unfortunately, during Phase 1 (and probably Phase 2), we will not be able to provide kid’s ministry services. Our ushers will happily provide family seating sections for you. Our hearts go out to our kids and families who are missing their friends and feeling the intensity of relational isolation during this emotional time.

If you are vulnerable, we ask you to plan on joining us from your home for church ONLINE at www.well.church , and as usual, if you are sick stay home. Please, let us know if we can help you in any way during this season.
