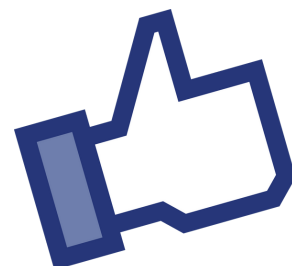

Throughout April, Young men and women had the opportunity to express themselves through art, as well as use critical thinking by sharing, inspiring, and creating solutions to prevent hate crimes and violence with activities including innovation, technology, art, and creativity.

The Juvenile Justice Center has also partnered with local artist Victor Casas and Ascarate Park to pay tribute to the 23 victims of the Walmart shooting in El Paso, Texas August 3, 2019.
