### ABOUT THE ROLE

For 9 weeks during the summer, camp instructors are responsible for coordinating and overseeing units of up to 12 campers 5 days a week, 8:30am-5:00pm, at our facility in Bracebridge. Units are also combined into teams to learn stunts, tumbling, jumps, and a routine to perform on Friday each week. Instructors will work together to coach skills and routines during 4 designated periods each day. Strong class management skills are required as well as proficiency in gymnastics and cheerleading instruction.

### ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Duties include, but are not limited to the following:

- Attend camp staff training June 27-30, 2022
- Plan, coordinate, and execute activities for campers each week
- Make camp fun, exciting, and memorable for all involved
- Develop age-appropriate games, crafts, and activities based around each week's theme
- Coach age-appropriate tumbling, stunts, jumps and dance
- Coach and choreograph basic cheer routines
- Willingness to clean and tidy the gym each day
- Mentor, guide, and utilise Junior Leaders and Coaches in Training
- Interest in the outdoors an asset
- Excellent social skills with young children
- Basic knowledge of computers and web applications
- Available 8:30am to 5:00pm each day
- Strong problem solving skills
- Communicate challenges with gym management and collaborate to find solutions
- Instructors should have their own transportation to and from camp each day
