All bid recipients programs and athletes must be in good standing with the IASF, and the Event Producer

Paid Bids: (Partial Paid)

- Paid Bids will be awarded to the Top Scoring bid eligible teams and/or
- Event Producer discretion may be factored into the final bid allocation.
- If necessary, bids may pass down in order of ranking by score.

At Large Bids:

- Will be awarded to the Top Scoring bid eligible team across all divisions.
- (1) Bid will be reserved as a NT bid if NT Bids are not allocated to the EP.
- Event producer discretion may be a factor in the final bid allocation.

Dance Score qualification requirements: Teams must score a minimum of 70 to be eligible for a bid..

Worlds Bid eligibility requirements are listed

PAID BIDS ELIGIBILITY;

• The program of the bid receiving teams must have 100% All Star program commitment for the event.

Scoring, Rule, Divisions

• All scoring, rules, and divisions will be on the 2023 IASF systems.



PRICING, REGISTRATIONS & TERMS CONDITIONS

- Event Registration prices are listed in AUD. All Prices are inclusive of GST. Prices can vary with 60 days notice.
- All pricing is per athlete per team/division and per registering program.
- Programs are not eligible to compete until they are registered and paid in full. Will not be put on the schedule without 50% payment
- Payment processing fee are at the cost of the customer
- Virtual registrations will be allowed for teams out of state at 50% of Athlete registration fee
- If an athlete crosses over to another program eg. Allstar to Scholastic they
 are treated as two customers and required to pay the fees associated
 registering for each program
- Late Registration Registrations after the close date will incur a late fee of \$250 per invoice and is not refundable
- Division Change Fee Changes made after first Schedule release will cost \$250.00 per team and is non refundable, Division change fees must be paid prior to a division change occuring. It is your responsibility to have this done prior to time frame for changes elapsing
- All Payments are due in full 30 Days prior to event start date. Programs not paid in full by this date may be removed from the event
- Event Merchandise Team not registered by the event close date may not appear on event merchandise
- Programs must be in good standings with All Things Cheer and Dance Australia to be accepted into the event
- All Things Cheer and Dance Australia may choose to not accept a registration based on previous history of payment or sportsmanship.

WAIVERS AND INSURANCE It is a condition of entry to submit a copy of the program's personal accident insurance Certificate of Currency upon registration.

If a Certificate of Currency is not provided, an insurance fee will be applied to each athlete's entry fee of \$5.50 per athlete registering.

The certificate of currency must be sent at time of registration.

Each Athlete must have a waiver completed and Each Program must complete a code of conduct form which are given prior to registration. A copy of the .

REFUND POLICY & TEAM CANCELLATION

Individual Withdrawal

28 Days or more to event commencing: 50% of Individual registration fee to be refunded to payer.

15-27 Days prior to event commencing: 25% of Individual registration fee to be refunded to payer.

14 days or less prior to event commencing: No refunds will be issued.

Invoices must be paid in full by registration close dates to have refunds issued.

Refunds will only be issued with a supporting medical certificate and processed 21 days after an event.

Claims must be given in writing to ATC&D Australia during given period and is subject to approval.

Team Cancellation 49 Days or more to event commencing: 50% of each Individual registration fee to be refunded to payer 30-48 Days prior to event commencing: 25% of each Individual registration fee to be refunded to payer

30 Days or less prior to the event commencing: No refunds. If an athlete is a cross over the above refund will be based on their crossover fee.

Team cancellations received after the event closing date will result in a full forfeiture of all monies paid, unless under special circumstances at the discretion of ATC&D.

ATHLETE & GYM OWNER CODE OF CONDUCT

By registering your team via the Hit Zero platform to compete at an ATC&D Event, you are agreeing to the following:

- 1. I have read, understand and will abide by all ATC rules and regulations.
- 2.I understand that competitive cheerleading or dance is an activity that presents the possibility of injury. As a coach who understands this risk, my athletes have received proper training.
- 3.I understand all risks and will always place more emphasis on the safety of my athletes than on competitiveness.
- 4.1 will follow all ATC rules and regulations. I understand that any violation of the rules and regulations could result in a penalty, point deduction, or disqualification.
- 5.1 will abide by the age and/or grade requirements (IASF Rules and Guidelines) for all divisions that my teams are competing in. I understand that I will be required to provide proper age and/or level verification at time of check in at an event. Falsifying age and/or grade requirements will result in disqualification from competition.
- 6.I will accept all judges' decisions as final and not question the integrity of said judges. If there is a valid protest, the head coach may file a complaint. If, for valid purpose, I register a complaint, I understand that this complaint will be addressed after the competition.
- 7. I understand that any action taken by a parent, family member, friend or competitor in approaching an ATC Staff member or judge will result in a penalty point deduction as well as forfeiting the coach's right to protest or review the tape.

At all times, I will support results of the competition as I am a role model for my program.

8. I will promote fairness and demonstrate appropriate sportsmanship throughout the competition, as well as require all persons affiliated with my program to conduct themselves with the same appropriate Sportsmanship.

I understand that ATC reserves the right to remove any persons from the competition for unsafe or unsportsmanlike actions. that may occur both onsite or on social media.

ATC&D SCORING

All Scoring is based on the ACSA scoring guidelines & IASF scoring guidelines for IASF divisions.

Event scoring is as listed:

- 1. Scoring process: ATC&D use the Hit Zero platform to score all Cheer and Dance performances. ATC&D uses Cheer Replay OR a form of video recording to capture all performances for deductions, legalities, and replay.
- Score Ranges: Difficulty scores are released via email OR text from Hit Zero within 15 minutes of each performance.
- a. Deductions: are released via email OR text from or email via video and Hit Zero.
- b. Divisions close 20 minutes after the last team's score ranges are released. All scores are final after official review and closure of the division

2. Score Reviews

- SCORE reviews: All initial reviews should take place via Hit Zero and the Hit Zero challenge process. Coaches must click the link on the received Difficulty ranges sheet to be taken into the review process. The review process is 10 minutes for one day events and 15 minutes for 2 day events.
- a. Virtual score check: If deemed necessary a virtual review process with an official in a zoom room will be available. There will be a 1 Coach limit on the zoom call.
- b. The courtesy review TV will be available for coaches who want to review their videos before submitting any reviews.

3. Final scores and Rankings

- a. ONE Day competition scores: Will not be released until after awards. Difficulty ranges will be released following the team's performance ASAP.
- b. TWO Day competition scores: Difficulty ranges will be released following the team's performance ASAP.
- c. Final scores will be released after the event enters it's stated awards period as per the pre-event email communication.

Level Champions

Are awarded to teams that compete on the same score sheet. This includes open teams. Non Tumble will be in it's own category.

IASF Teams:

- Are not eligible for level champions with ACSA teams.
- IASF Teams are included in program champion

Tie Breaker: In the event there is a tie for a Bid, the Event Director will award the team with the highest raw score after two rounds of competition.

ATC&D JUDGES

ATC&D prides itself on the position of experience and knowledge bought to the Australian Cheerleading market based on the quality and consistency of the judges brought to event experiences.

Whether in person, or virtual judging occurs, ATC&D leans on its decades of experience and prestigious industry networks to ensure the Australian All Star market is receiving the highest quality of personal to critique and provide feedback to all routines.

With the ever-changing nature of technology, and the evolving global travel situation, ATC&D will announce judges for the 2023 season via the official event email correspondence prior to an event too maintain integrity and transparency with all coaching personal and gym owners.

It is an expectation that judges are not contacted via social media, or others forms of communication outside of the approved ATC&D Communication channels. Any attempt to contact judges prior to, during or post event will lead to consequential action as per the decision of the ATC&D directors.

Our judging panel each year consists of reputable judges from Australia, The United States, and the United Kingdom & Europe.

PRE EVENT REGISTRATIONS

Registrations will open on the Friday prior to the event commencement. Booking times will be addressed in the pre-event email, and coaches or gym owners are encouraged to email marketing@allthingscheer.com.au to secure their preferred time. ATC&D always encourages pre-event day registration to ensure ease on the day of competition. All bookings must be sent to Waivers must be submitted to Hit Zero prior to pre-event registrations. In the registration meeting you will be given your wrist bands for each session throughout the event. It will be your responsibility to get them to athletes. Wrist bands are to be given to registered athletes only. The number of wrist bands will reflect the number submitted in your registration process on Hit Zero. Coaches passes will be distributed during this meeting. All coaches must have provided their current working with children check information and coaches' credentials to the Hit Zero registration process. Coaches without a valid working with children check will not be given a coach pass, and will not be granted access to ATC&D event zoned areas. No exceptions apply. The collecting coach or gym owner will be required to check all information is correct, and sign for the athletes passes and coaches passes.

ONSITE COMMUNICATION

All scoring communication will be distributed to the registered email address used to register in HitZero. It is the gym owners responsibility to ensure the correct information for an onsite representative are submitted via HitZero pre event. No changes or updates to contact information will be made on the day of the event. Cheer Replay will use the contact information registered with the Hit Zero.
