St. Croix in Virgin Islands

Several witnesses reported seeing what at first appeared to be a large shooting star. But its downward trajectory came within striking distance of the ground; brushing over the tops of trees. The object was described as a wingless fuselage fifty meters in length. Three landing lights alternated in color from the nose back to the tail and approached STX. The altitude dropped to five kilometers before veering away from the runway and under local radar. One STX Employee who asked to remain anonymous said the craft looked as if it was going to crash, entered a low lying cloud two miles inland, and then vanished. Size of object: fifty meters. Shape: thinly shaped delta wing
