My Girlfriend and I went out to grab something to eat at Taco Bell. We got our food and drove north on University Avenue and then we drove east on College Road. As we drove I happened to notice and point out a light in the sky that emanated a glow somewhat like a flash light shining through a crystal. Otherwise it looked like a normal star.
