Mr Victor street, site of the sighting

On the evening of Thursday, September 8, 2005, I've got the excited telephone call from Victor, a resident on Sergeyeva-Tsenskogo Street 34, in the old downtown of Simferopol. He reported that he just saw a UFO. At 20:55 he was walking his dog near the building of the Soviet of Ministers, on the corner of Lenin Square, right in the center of Simferopol. He got the ache in his legs, and when he raised his eyes up, he saw the bright object at northeastern part of the sky, emitting white or white-bluish light, approximately 10 times brighter than Venus, as he said! The object hovered in the sky for several seconds, and then began to move quickly, zooming up and gaining speed. The UFO then quickly disappeared from sight. It probably left the terrestrial atmosphere to enter the space over our peninsula. Total time of the observation was about 15 seconds.
