Note - No military vehicle movements on show days unless authorised and marshalled. Exhibitors can arrive on Friday between 2pm and 9pm for setting up and enjoying the evening entertainment. All vehicles must be in position by 8am on show days. Entry may be denied after this time for health and safety reasons.

No children allowed on jeeps without parental supervision and the permission of the owners.

Vehicle owners must ensure visitors do not touch or climb on their vehicle without the owner's express permission. They must display a sign making that restriction clear and must not leave their vehicle unattended at any time. Failure to follow this procedure will mean any liability for damage or injury resting with the vehicle owner.
