


- The New Jersey State Trapshooting Association is pleased to offer half price targets to Sub-Junior and Junior shooters for all NJSTA events. Shooters receiving reduced pricing are not eligible to play options or purses.
- Ties will be decided by either; forward run, longest run, reverse run, or reverse high score by sub event, to be determined by a drawing at the end of the event.
- Management will not be responsible for errors on scores after the options have been figured and posted on the scoreboard.
- HAA and HOA ties will be broken by the best two out of three event scores
- The clubs reserve the right to reject any entry.
- Lunch may be obtained on the grounds.
- Anyone winning a trophy must pick it up, as no trophies will be shipped.
- Zone shoots will be held regardless of the weather.
- A shooter may win only one trophy in any event.

TROPHY HIERARCHY FOR ALL ZONE SHOOTS

Shooters may declare only one category: i.e. lady, sub-junior, junior, veteran, senior veteran. A shooter may no longer declare, for example, lady veteran. (Note: this rule does not apply to chair shooters.)

Any shooter who is tied for event champion may shoot off/carry over for the champion trophy. If the shooter fails in the championship trophy shoot off/carry over and has declared a special category, the shooter will fall back to their declared category.

Any shooter who has declared a special category at classification and whose score qualified him/her for any trophy in his/her declared category will compete for the category trophy and not for place, class or yardage group.

A category shooter whose score does not qualify him/her for his/her category may compete for place, class or yardage group.

REGISTRATION CERTIFICATION

This certifies that the New Jersey State Trapshooting Association has been authorized to hold registered shoots. Amateur Trapshooting Association rules will govern these shoots and the scores will be included in the Official Records.

TARGET REQUIREMENTS

16 YARD: A shooter not having at least 500 16-yard targets on their current target year card AND a total of 1000 targets on their current and previous target year cards combined will be penalized 2 classes, not to exceed Class AA.

HANDICAP: A shooter not having at least 500 handicap targets on their current target year card AND a total of 1000 targets on their current and previous target year cards combined will be penalized 2 yards, not to exceed 26 yards.

DOUBLES: A shooter not having at least 500 double targets on their current target year card AND a total of 1000 targets on their current and previous target year cards combined will be penalized 2 classes, not to exceed Class A.

SENIOR VETERAN: Shooters over the age of 70, no handicap requirements. All Senior Veterans will shoot from last assigned yardage. Must have 300 singles and 300 doubles for current target year or be penalized.

NORTH/SOUTH ZONE TEAM SELECTIONS: Team member selections will be based on Zone Singles Championship scores. Tie scores, used to select zone team members, will be decided based on reverse sub event scores, then reverse long run if necessary.

NOTE: Due to the date of the Northern Zone, the current target year requirement will be waived.



2023 HALL OF FAME INDUCTEE

Peter Frederiks

Biography # 3504850

Peter was born in February 1942 and grew up on a farm in Three Bridges, New Jersey. Growing up working the farm with his Dad, Pete grew fond of John Deere Tractors and always admired them when he came across one during his adult years. He graduated high school and joined the Navy during the Viet Nam War, after completing his four years of duty, he attended Rutgers University under the GI Bill. Upon graduation Pete relocated to Rosemont, just outside of Flemington, where he bought a house and opened a machine shop a mile down the road, which he owned for the next 40 years. As business went on. he had great years and slow years and during all that time two of his workers stayed with him for the last 25 years and when it came time to retire, he turned the business over to them.



Pete married his first wife Rose and had three daughters. His wife passed away in 2010. Pete remarried in 2013 to Theresa "Tess" Chamberlain, who accompanied him to shoots up and down the East coast and out to the Grand in Sparta. Speaking of Grands, Pete had just received a patch for attending 45-Grands in a row. Pete was on the "Last Squad" at the Vandalia Facility back in 2005. Fellow trap shooter Ed Yanchok, the past New Jersey ATA Delegate, contacted the ATA prior to the Grand and offered a donation to the ATA to reserve the last squad on the last event of the competition, and Pete was eager to be a member of the squad.

During Pete's ATA tenure he resided in New Jersey and Pennsylvania, with his business in New Jersey. While living in New Hope, he became a member of the Board of Directors at Flourtown Sandy Run, where he oversaw registered ATA shooting. Pete won trophies at the Grand, Eastern Zone, Dixie Grand, Southern Grand, Pennsylvania Grand, Jersey Cricket, the New Jersey State Shoot, Delaware, Pennsylvania. He competed in Hawaii a few times and Alaska once. He was on the New Jersey State Team in 1999 and 2015. Pete joined the ATA in 1972 and from then until 2020, he registered 541,425 singles, 122,700 handicap and 253,350 doubles targets, totaling 917,475!

Pete was well liked by all in his community of Rosemont. Pete was home with his wife Tess when he had the heart attack. When the 911 call went out there were 15 vehicles responding between EMT's and Police. Pete was liked by all. Peter died in March of 2020.

As mentioned earlier, Pete was predeceased by his first wife Rose and two of his three daughters. He is survived by his wife Tess and daughter Claudine. Claudine the remaining daughter was a junior trap shooter, when growing up, and resides in Florida. His wife Tess Fredriks also resides in Florida.


He is being inducted into the New Jersey Trap Shooting Hall of Fame for his shooting ability and contributions to the sport of trapshooting over the years.

2023 HALL OF FAME INDUCTEE

Thomas Green Sr..

Thomas Green Sr. was born in Vineland, New Jersey August 8th, 1960 and has lived in South Jersey his entire life. He has fond memories of hunting in and around the area as a young man with family and friends for small game and deer. His adventures took him deer hunting as far north as the woods of Maine.

Tom graduated from Buena High School in 1978. It was during high school that he started working for Jim and Bob Pagliughi at their gun shop in Vineland. Weekend duties included traveling to the various ATA clubs of New Jersey in the store truck with Jimmy Pagliughi and Roger Linton selling ammunition and reloading components to the shooters. In those days we never had to worry about supply shortages and high prices!



It was the year 1975, during one of Tom's Friday night visits to Seabrook Gun Club which had 2 trap fields and a skeet field, that he caught the Trapshooting bug! He continued shooting Trap at that club and in 1976, the very next year, he joined the ATA and began registering targets. He concluded his first year with a 80 average on 1300 singles targets and a 76 on 600 in handicap.

In the Spring of 1978, as a 17 year old senior in High School, he won the New Jersey State Handicap Championship.

After shooting Trap for 4 years Tom had upped his singles average to 91.25 and handicap to 85.17. During the 1981 season he decided to add doubles to his resume and ended the year shooting 69.2 on 250 doubles targets—we all have to start somewhere!

His practice and dedication to the sport showed and by 1989 his average card read as follows: Singles 97.23, Handicap 89.30, and Doubles 89.80, this performance landed him on the State Team! An accomplishment he held until 1994 when work and family took precedence. Although he continued shooting he did not accrue enough targets to qualify him for the team.

He has visited and shot at many clubs that are but memories to Tom and the shooters of New Jersey. He attended the last Jersey Cricket at the Atlantic City Gun Club before it closed. He was fortunate enough to shoot over the water at the Old Mill Trap and Skeet Club. Shot with Harry Miller at Thunder Mountain in New Jersey, Shot targets at the Quaker City Gun Club. And I would be remiss if George and Nyda Wright at the Salem County Sportsmans Club were not included in the above list.





GREAT EASTERN PURSE – The purse pays out the following percentages to the top 6 scores in the event: 25% to top score, 15% to second, 10% to 3rd. The 4th score will win 25%, the 5th score 15% and the 6th score 10% of the monies taken in.

PERFECT MIDDLE 50 – On Friday and Sunday's Handicap race there will be a perfect middle 50 purse. A \$10 entry fee is required to enter. All entered perfect 50s will divide the purse. If there are no perfect 50s on Wednesday, the purse will be carried over to Thursday's Handicap (or Sunday's) middle 50 event. An additional \$10 fee will be necessary to remain in contention for the purse. If the 50s are not broken on the Sunday Handicap Event, monies will be paid to the 49s or highest score in that 50, that played the option. All ties split the purse.

JUNIOR & SUB-JUNIOR FEES – The NJSTA, in oder to promote shooting by our young shooters, is offering half price targets for all NJSTA events. The Pine Belt Sportsman's Club has volunteered to pay the remaining half of the target price plus the daily fees for the Saturday and Sunday Championship events with the hope that it will allow more young shooters to take part in the NJ State shoot. Shooters receiving reduced price targets are not eligible to enter any options or purses.

STATE SHOOT AND SATELLITE PINS – 100 and 200 Straight Pins – A 100 straight pin will be given to any shooter who breaks a 100 in any event. Any shooter who breaks a 200 in a 200-bird event will be eligible for a pin. A person may only win one of each type pin during their shooting career.

NJSTA RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS – No person may compete for NJSTA trophies unless he/she, for the immediate preceding six (6) months, has been a bona fide resident of New Jersey and the ATA. No person may compete for any NJ trophies or titles in more than one (1) State each target year. However, nothing shall preclude a shooter from returning to the former State residence and competing for trophies in the event he/she has not been a bona fide resident of another State for the immediately preceding six (6) month period prior to such competition. In case there is a dispute with respect to the residence of a shooter attending a State tournament, it shall be the duty of the State Association to rule as to said shooter's right to compete as a resident shooter. The ruling of the State Association shall be final.

CLASSIFICATION AND HANDICAPPING

A competent classification committee will be on duty and all shooters will be classified and/or handicapped according to A.T.A. regulations, averages, past year's performance and known ability, which includes non-registered shooting.

Shooters who do not have their scores posted and averaged up-to-date on their A.T.A. cards will be assigned Class and Yardage at the discretion of the committee.

CLASS - YARDAGE ADVANCEMENT

Beginning day one, any shooter resident or non-resident, who wins and/or ties for a singles or doubles championship trophy or class trophy or has the high score in that event or class, shall be increased a minimum of one class. Shooters earning yardage must have their card punched before participating in their next handicap event.

TARGET REQUIREMENTS

16 YARD: A shooter not having at least 500 16-yard targets on their current target year card AND a total of 1000 16-yard targets on their current target year card combined will be penalized 2 classes, not to exceed Class AA.

HANDICAP: A shooter not having at least 500 handicap targets on their current target year card AND a total of 1000 handicap targets on their current target year card combined will be penalized 2 yards, not to exceed 26 yards.

DOUBLES: A shooter not having at least 500 double targets on their current target year card AND a total of 1000 doubles targets on their current target year card combined will be penalized 2 classes, not to exceed Class A.

SENIOR VETERAN: Shooters over the age of 70, no handicap requirements. All Senior Veterans will shoot from last assigned yardage. Must have 300 singles and 300 doubles for current target year or be penalized.

NOTE: All target requirements must be met prior to Event 1.


