

- The New Jersey State Trapshooting Association is pleased to offer half price targets to Sub-Junior and Junior shooters for all NJSTA events. Shooters receiving reduced pricing are not eligible to play options or purses.
- Ties will be decided by these methods, in this order, by sub event scores; reverse run, forward run, then longest run. If a tie still exists for two shooters, a coin flip will be used. The shooter with the lowest squad and position will be heads. If a tie exists for more than two shooters, cards will be drawn. The shooter with the lowest squad and position is the first card drawn, and so on.
- Management will not be responsible for errors on scores after the options have been figured and posted on the scoreboard.
- HAA and HOA ties will be broken by the best two out of three event scores, then by a coin flip if still tied.
- The clubs reserve the right to reject any entry.
- Lunch may be obtained on the grounds.
- Anyone winning a trophy must pick it up, as no trophies will be shipped.
- Zone shoots will be held regardless of the weather.

TROPHY HIERARCHY FOR ALL ZONE SHOOT

Shooters may declare only one category: i.e. lady, sub-junior, junior, veteran, senior veteran. A shooter may no longer declare, for example, lady veteran. (Note: this rule does not apply to chair shooters.)

Any shooter who is tied for event champion may shoot off/carry over for the champion trophy. If the shooter fails in the championship trophy shoot off/carry over and has declared a special category, the shooter will fall back to their declared category.

Any shooter who has declared a special category at classification and whose score qualified him/her for any trophy in his/her declared category will compete for the category trophy and not for place, class or yardage group.

A category shooter whose score does not qualify him/her for his/her category may compete for place, class or yardage group.

REGISTRATION CERTIFICATION

This certifies that the New Jersey State Trapshooting Association has been authorized to hold registered shoots. Amateur Trapshooting Association rules will govern these shoots and the scores will be included in the Official Records.

ZONE CLASSIFICATION

16 Yard Classification

A CLASS – 95% and over
B CLASS – 92% and under 95%
C CLASS – 89% and under 92%
D CLASS – under 89%

Doubles Classification

A 90 percent and over
B 85 percent and under 90
C 78 percent and under 85
D Under 78 percent

TARGET REQUIREMENTS

16 YARD: A shooter not having a total of 1,000 16-yard targets on their current target year card AND previous year cards combined will be penalized 2 classes, not to exceed Class A. Of the 1,000 targets, at least 500 targets must be in the current target year.

HANDICAP: A shooter not having at least 1,000 handicap targets on their current target year card AND previous target year cards combined will be penalized 2 yards, not to exceed 25 yards. Of the 1,000 targets, at least 500 targets must be in the current target year.

DOUBLES: A shooter not having at least 1,000 double targets on their current target year card AND previous target year cards combined will be penalized 2 classes, not to exceed Class A. Of the 1,000 targets, at least 500 targets must be in the current target year.

ALL SHOOTERS OVER THE AGE OF 70: No handicap requirements. These shooters will shoot from last assigned yardage. Must have 300 singles and 300 doubles for current target year or be penalized.

NORTH/SOUTH ZONE TEAM SELECTIONS: Team member selections will be based on State Singles Championship scores. Tie scores, used to select zone team members, will be decided based on reverse sub event scores, then reverse long run if necessary.

NOTE: Due to the date of the Northern Zone, the current target year requirement will be waived, however, the 1,000 target minimum applies



To qualify for the State Teams, all shooters must participate in the 16-yard, handicap, and doubles championships at that year's State shoot (Saturday and Sunday). For the men's and veteran's teams, they are also required to shoot a minimum of 2500 16-yard targets, 1500 handicap targets and 1000 doubles during the preceding ATA year; and for the ladies state team 2000 16-yard targets, 1000 handicap targets and 500 doubles. Junior State Team 1000 16-yard targets, 500 handicap targets, and 500 doubles.

To qualify as a "New Jersey Top Shooter" in a specific discipline the following minimum target requirements are as follows. Singles 2,500 targets, Handicap 1,500 targets, Doubles 1,000 targets. Minimum target requirements are evaluated individually for each discipline. A shooter may qualify for more than one discipline when the minimum target requirement is met for that discipline.

2026 HALL OF FAME INDUCTEE

GEORGE P. HESS

GEORGE P. HESS was born in March of 1900 to John and Lydia Hess of North Catasauqua, Pennsylvania. He was the youngest of four children. When he was in the eighth grade, he decided to quit school and go to work to learn to be a plumber. After being certified as a master plumber, he joined the Allentown plumber's union and worked in that area until he was 30 years old. He relocated to Woodstown, New Jersey and married Ethel Ryan of Newport, New Jersey, that same year. In 1940 he started his own plumbing business in Woodstown, which he operated until his retirement in 1970. During this period, he was the chairman of the Woodstown Kiwanis Club for Underprivileged Children's Fund along with another NJ State Champion, Paul Davis of Woodstown. Together they ran turkey shoots to raise money for food and clothing for local needy children.



In 1946 he became a member of ATA and started to shoot on weekends at Algonquin, PRR, Pine Valley, Seabrook, Atlantic City, and Quaker city, amongst other clubs. In 1949 he won the New Jersey State Singles Championship and on the next day the New State Jersey Handicap Championship which qualified him to go to the Grand American to shoot in the Champion of Champions race where he broke a 96. He was a member of the 1949 "Remington Shooting Stars" and a member of the first perfect squad at Pine Valley Gun Club. George returned to trap shooting when he retired in 1970 and became a lifetime ATA member. He went on to capture the New Jersey State Veteran's Championship in 1976 with a score of 195. During his career, he attended fifteen New Jersey State Shoots and seven New Jersey Southern Zone Shoots. Throughout the years he passed his knowledge of shooting along to many new young shooters. In his retirement years, he was a substitute plumbing teacher at Cumberland and Salem vocational schools, ATA trap shooter John Tierno was one of his students. He was also an avid quail hunter who always owned a bird dog. George and Ethel Hess enjoyed 51 years of marriage. George passed away in 1981.



2026 HALL OF FAME INDUCTEE

GEORGE C. HESS

GEORGE C. HESS was born in March 1939 in Woodbury, New Jersey, the son of George P. and Ethel Hess. The family later moved to South Main Street in Woodstown, New Jersey. During this time, George's father encouraged his involvement in the shooting sports, beginning as a trap boy and eventually learning to shoot targets while in high school. George grew up in Woodstown and graduated from Woodstown High School in 1956.

He went on to graduate from the Rutgers College of Pharmacy and became a staff pharmacist at Wilmington Medical Center, where he worked for nine years. In 1971, George opened Hess Pharmacy in Bridgeton, New Jersey, practicing there for 30 years until his retirement.



In 1967, George and his father both became life members of the Amateur Trapshooting Association (ATA). George also became a lifetime member of Pine Belt Sportsman's Club. In his first year of shooting registered targets, George shot 1,500 singles and achieved an average of 92.5 percent. Over the next three years, he maintained an average of 90 percent before taking a hiatus from competitive shooting until his retirement.

His return to the sport was marked by notable success. He won his yardage group at the Pine Valley Ladybird Shoot in 2007, followed by the Singles High Veteran title at the 2008 Pine Valley Club Shoot. In 2009, he earned the Senior Veteran Handicap title at the New Jersey State Shoot, held at Pine Belt Sportsman's Club, with an impressive score of 97. In 2010, he won the Senior Veteran Handicap at the Pine Valley Club Shoot.

George continued his success at Pine Belt Club Shoots, earning the Singles High Senior Veteran trophy in 2011, the Club Handicap Champion trophy in 2015, the Senior Veteran Handicap Champion trophy in 2020, and again in 2022. His current 16-yard average stands at 90.45 percent, with a handicap average of 84.54 percent.

George and his wife, Brenda, are celebrating 25 years of marriage. They make their home in Elk Township, New Jersey, and are both lifelong residents of the state. George has a stepson, Brian Nocenti, and daughter-in-law Effie, who have three children—Lilly, Brian, and Ellie. George and Brenda greatly enjoy spending time with their grandchildren and visiting Brian and his family in Kennett Square, Pennsylvania.

George served for many years as a valued board member of Pine Belt Sportsman's Club and is also celebrating thirteen years of membership at the South Florida Shooting Club in Palm City, Florida. Reflecting on his journey, George says, "It has been a pleasure to enjoy the trapshooting experience throughout my life, especially the many treasured friendships made along the way with fellow shooters. I am honored to share the 2026 nomination with my father."

CLASSIFICATION AND HANDICAPPING

A competent classification committee will be on duty and all shooters will be classified and/or handicapped according to A.T.A. regulations, averages, past year's performance and known ability, which includes non-registered shooting.

Shooters who do not have their scores posted and averaged up-to-date on their A.T.A. cards will be assigned Class and Yardage at the discretion of the committee.

CLASS - YARDAGE ADVANCEMENT

Beginning day one, in all events that include class advances, all shooters (regardless of Category) with scores that equal or exceed the score of the class champion, will be advanced starting with the next like event. Shooters earning yardage must have their card punched before participating in their next handicap event.

TARGET REQUIREMENTS

16 YARD: A shooter not having a total of 1,000 16-yard targets on their current target year card AND previous year cards combined will be penalized 2 classes, not to exceed Class A. Of the 1,000 targets, at least 500 targets must be in the current target year.

HANDICAP: A shooter not having at least 1,000 handicap targets on their current target year card AND previous target year cards combined will be penalized 2 yards, not to exceed 25 yards. Of the 1,000 targets, at least 500 targets must be in the current target year.

DOUBLES: A shooter not having at least 1,000 double targets on their current target year card AND previous target year cards combined will be penalized 2 classes, not to exceed Class A. Of the 1,000 targets, at least 500 targets must be in the current target year.

ALL SHOOTERS OVER THE AGE OF 70: No handicap requirements. These shooters will shoot from last assigned yardage. Must have 300 singles and 300 doubles for current target year or be penalized.

NOTE: All target requirements must be met prior to Event 1.

GREAT EASTERN PURSE – The purse pays out the following percentages to the top 6 scores in the event: 25% to top score, 15% to second, 10% to 3rd. The 4th score will win 25%, the 5th score 15% and the 6th score 10% of the monies taken in.

PERFECT MIDDLE 50 – On Friday and Sunday's Handicap race there will be a perfect middle 50 purse. A \$10 entry fee is required to enter. All entered perfect 50s will divide the purse. If there are no perfect 50s on Thursday, the purse will be carried over to Sunday's Handicap middle 50 event. An additional \$10 fee will be necessary to remain in contention for the purse. If the 50s are not broken on the Sunday Handicap Event, monies will be paid to the 49s or highest score in that 50, that played the option. All ties split the purse.

JUNIOR & SUB-JUNIOR FEES – The NJSTA, in order to promote participation by our young shooters, is offering half price targets for all NJSTA events. The Pine Belt Sportsman's Club has volunteered to pay the remaining half of the target price plus the daily fees for the Saturday and Sunday Championship events with the hope that it will allow more young shooters to take part in the NJ State shoot. Shooters receiving reduced price targets are not eligible to enter any options or purses.

STATE SHOOT AND SATELLITE PINS – 100 and 200 Straight Pins – A 100 straight pin will be given to any shooter who breaks a 100 in any event. Any shooter who breaks a 200 in a 200-bird event will be eligible for a pin. A person may only win one of each type pin during their shooting career.

NJSTA RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS – No person may compete for NJSTA Resident trophies unless he/she, for the immediate preceding six (6) months, has been a bona fide resident of New Jersey and a member of the ATA. No person may compete for any NJ trophies or titles in more than one (1) State each target year. However, nothing shall preclude a shooter from returning to the former State residence and competing for trophies in the event he/she has not been a bona fide resident of another State for the immediately preceding six (6) month period prior to such competition. In case there is a dispute with respect to the residence of a shooter attending a State tournament, it shall be the duty of the State Association to rule as to said shooter's right to compete as a resident shooter. The ruling of the State Association shall be final.

The Pine Belt Sportsman's Club, in order to promote participation by our young shooters, has volunteered to pay for up to half of the target price plus the daily fees for the Saturday and Sunday events, with the hope that it will allow more young shooters to take part in the state shoot. Shooters receiving half price targets will not be eligible to enter any options or purses.

GENERAL INFORMATION

ALL TIES INVOLVING TROPHIES, THAT ARE NOT CARRIED OVER, WILL BE SHOT OFF IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING EACH DAY'S PROGRAM. ANY SHOOTER FAILING TO APPEAR FOR HIS/HER SHOOT-OFF WILL FORFEIT HIS/HER TROPHY RIGHT.

Advance paid entries will be accepted starting Wednesday afternoon for all events.

A shooter may make only one entry per event. Once the entry has been made the cashier will not accept additional options or purse money from the shooter. **POSITIVELY NO CHANGES, WITHDRAWALS OR REFUNDS WILL BE ALLOWED AFTER MAKING ENTRY.**

Veterans (past 65th birthday), Sr. Veterans (past 70th birthday), Juniors (under 18 years of age), Sub-juniors (under 15 years of age) and Female contestants must make sure their entry card is marked at the time they are being classified and squadded.

When there is a Junior and Sub-Junior A.T.A. and/or State Trophy, the Junior must take the Junior trophy and the Sub-Junior must take the Sub-Junior trophy regardless of the high score between the two of them.

All events will start at the prescribed time. Each shooter is cautioned – it is your responsibility to know when your squad is up. If you are not present, your squad will start without you and you will be re-squadded at management's discretion.
