AS WE GATHER

The ancient name for today, the Fifth Sunday in Lent, is Judica, the Latin behind "vindicate" in the Introit. This Sunday prepares us for next Sunday's review of the Passion. Only in Christ are we truly vindicated. But the emphasis is on our response to God's love and forgiveness. In today's Gospel, Jesus inverts the usual triangle of power into an upsidedown pyramid of service. The greatest in God's kingdom, the position sought by His disciples in the Gospel, is now at the bottom, serving everyone above. Jesus is describing Himself! In contrast to priests who repeatedly pray for others and offer sacrifices also for their own sins, Jesus was a one-time priest, offering Himself as the sacrifice while being sinless. In this new covenant, promised in the Reading from Jeremiah, we know of our Lord's great love, now written in our hearts. From the inside out, our desire is to return Christ's sacrificial, forgiving love by serving one another in His name.

Drive Up Communion Distribution

Starting today, we will begin to offer communion distribution to members inside their vehicles on the first and third Sundays of the month (until we are able to begin gathering in the building). In order to prepare for the reception of Holy Communion it is expected that all who come to receive will either watch the regular live streamed service at home, before driving to the church, or you may participate in the live service by listening to it on the radio. We will be broadcasting all our church services to the parking lot over FM radio.

During the communion service, Pastor will consecrate the elements on the altar, and conclude the service. After the service has "ended" Pastor and one elder will distribute communion to people in their cars, from the parking lot for 30 minutes after the live broadcast / internet service has ended. If you will need more than 30 minutes to get to the church please make arrangements with Pastor ahead of time and he will be happy to wait for you.

As always, we practice closed communion, meaning that we only commune those who share altar and pulpit fellowship with LCC. If you are not a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church please speak with Pastor Chris before the service if you wish to receive the sacrament.
