#### AS WE GATHER

Sunday, "the eighth day of the week," is celebrated by Christians as the first day of the eternal life into which they were baptized. #### St. Paul's Lutheran Church Indoor Worship Service Information, as of March 27, 2021

Greetings in the name of Christ,

On Thursday March 25<sup>th</sup> BC Public Health Authorities have temporarily granted religious communities the opportunity to meet indoors for services. Here is a summary of what our services will look like.

- We are allowed to choose four days in which to hold indoor services between Palm Sunday and Ascension (May 13<sup>th</sup>).
  We are allowed to have multiple service times on those four days, as long as we follow strict sanitization between services.
- 2- We will plan to hold services on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Sunday April 18<sup>th</sup>, and Sunday May 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- 3- We will gather no more than 15 people per service (including Pastor) but we are allowed 2 Elders in addition to the 15 people to help make sure we are following all covid protocols.
- 4- We are required to caution anyone over 70 yrs old and those who have underlying health issues, that attending an in-person service will put them at higher risk of serious complications if they contract Covid-19.

5- Anyone who wishes to attend an in-person service must pre-register by calling, texting, or emailing Pastor Chris at least 2 days prior to the service being attended. If you are not able to make a service that you registered for, please let Pastor know asap.

- 6- If you are feeling unwell, or showing symptoms of Covid 19 you must not attend an in-person service until you are well again.
- 7- Masks will be required except for those who are leading / reading. You may temporarily remove a mask for communion, and those under 12 years are not required to wear one.
- 8- Congregational singing is not allowed according to the restrictions. One soloist may sing if precautions are in place... (any volunteers?)
- 9- We are not allowed to gather socially indoors, before or after the service. If you have any other questions or concerns please give Pastor a call 250-467-3801
