Those veterans who enlisted or were commissioned, or discharged from military service, while residing in Meredith who served during the following conflicts:

- US Revolutionary War (April 19, 1775-September 3, 1883)
- War of 1812 (June 18, 1812-February 18, 1815)
- Mexican-American War (April 25, 1846 February 2, 1848
- US Civil War (April 12, 1861-April 9, 1865)
- Spanish American War (April 21, 1898-December 10, 1898)
- World War I (April 6, 1917-November 1, 1918)
- World War II (December 7, 1941-December 31, 1946)
- Korean War (June 27, 1950-January 31, 1955)
- Vietnam War (November 1 1955-May 7, 1975 serving inside the Republic of Vietnam; August 5, 1964-May 7, 1975 serving outside the Republic of Vietnam.)
- Post Vietnam Era Conflicts: Lebanon & Grenada August 24, 1982 to July 31, 1984, Panama December 20, 1989 to January 31, 1990, 1st Gulf War Aug 2, 1990 Nov 30, 1995
- Global War on Terror (Sep 11, 2001 to present)
