

Rosemary



Rosemary is an easy plant to grow. It is an ornamental evergreen shrub that tastes great in many dishes. It is imperative for the soil to be well-drained and evenly moist at first. As the plant takes root it becomes drought tolerant. It is an excellent plant for containers. Rosemary has a stronger flavor when fresh than when it is dried. You can cut the sprigs anytime for use. Trim the plant regularly so you will get tender new stems. If not, it gets woody.

Important Info:

Full sun

Well-drained soil that is on the dry side

Grows 24-26 inches tall
