

## **Section 3: Further integration**

## **Crucial points**

- 1. Be careful when integrating negative and fractional powers Make sure that you add 1 to the index correctly, and remember that you must divide by the **new** index.
- 2. Remember that you cannot yet integrate  $x^n$  for n = -1The rule for integrating  $x^n$  is valid for all values of *n* except for n = -1. You

will learn to integrate  $\frac{1}{x}$  in A level Mathematics.

3. Look out for discontinuities when finding the area under a graph Remember that you cannot integrate across a discontinuity. See Example 5 in the Notes and Examples.
