Scholarship Acceptance Agreement

Congratulations! You have been awarded a Grace Tinsley Scholarship in recognition of the achievements you have made during your years at Charlottesville High School. You have distinguished yourself among your peers and promise to be a strong candidate for success at the college level. Recognition also goes to your parents, other family members, teachers, mentors, and friends who have nurtured you along the way.

In order for us to send a scholarship check to your college, you must complete the following steps. Required documents should be uploaded through the <u>New Scholar Google Form</u>, which also allows you to keep your contact information up to date. Feel free to keep a copy of this acceptance agreement and use it as your checklist!

- 1. <u>Sign and upload this form</u> through the <u>New Scholar Google Form</u> to accept your scholarship and to let us know that you understand the procedure for claiming and renewing your scholarship for your second year of college. Parents/Guardians should also sign for scholars who are not yet 18 years old.
- 2. Complete the **contact information questions** on the **New Scholar Google Form**. You can come back to that form anytime you need to update your information.
- 3. Please upload a **photograph of yourself** to the **New Scholar Google Form** to post on our website. Your senior picture would be great!
- 4. When you've made a final decision about the school you will attend, enter your college **Student Identification number** on the **New Scholar Google Form** as soon as it has been assigned to you.
- 5. Have your college registrar sign and return to you your <u>Verification of Enrollment/Pre-Registration Form</u>, and then upload it to the <u>New Scholar Google Form</u>. If the registrar would prefer to email it directly to us at scholars@gracetinsleyscholarship.org, that's fine. Each college has different rules about when it considers students enrolled or pre-registered. Talk to the registrar to find out your school's procedure.
- 6. Upload a copy or screenshot of your college <u>Tuition Invoice</u> to the <u>New Scholar Google Form</u> when it becomes available later in the summer.
- 7. Familiarize yourself with the <u>instructions and requirements</u> on our website for <u>renewing your scholarship for your second year of college</u>. Renewals are due by March 1 of the scholar's first year of college and consist of a personal statement and complete transcript uploaded through the <u>Renewing Scholar Google Form</u>, as well as contact information and financial questions answered on the Google Form itself. Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA to renew their scholarships. Grace Tinsley Scholarship Program may publish all or part of your renewing scholar personal statement on our website.
- 8. Finally, if you decide not to enroll in school or to withdraw, please do so before the deadline for withdrawals and let us know immediately so that your money can be returned to the scholarship program. If you decide you would like to defer enrollment, please let us know immediately so we can discuss options for deferral of your scholarship payments.
