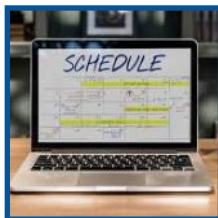

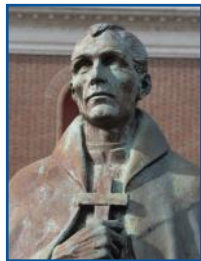


Father Michael McGivney

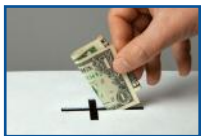
