Three Reasons Why You Need Jesus:

Jesus loves you! He desires to have a relationship with you and give you a life full of joy and purpose. Why do you need Him in your life?

- 1. Because you have a past.** You can't go back, but He can. The Bible says, “Jesus Christ the same yesterday and today and forever” (Hebrews 13:8). He can walk into those places of sin and failure wipe the slate clean, and give you a new beginning.

IN CASE YOU WERE WONDERING...

A **class** is a small group that meets regularly for the purpose of building the church community and growing into a deeper understanding of God by: promoting connectivity within the congregation, offering close, committed, and accepting relationships, and offering teachings in a small-group setting.

Class Leaders are persons assigned to each class. Class Leaders are appointed annually by the Pastor. They shall serve for one year and may be appointed as long as their conduct is satisfactory. Class Leaders are “called” disciples. They are called because they have shown certain qualities in their lifestyles that reflect the Spirit of Christ.
