A Psalm of David, Psalm 19 depicts God as Creator and Law Giver. "Like Ps. 8, this hymn uses creation to motivate reflection—it is a peaceful oasis after the drama of the lament and victory psalms. [Psalm 19] begins with creation as a source of wisdom, then moves to God's word as the perfect source of wisdom, and ends with the human need for redemption." (NLT Study Bible)

As such, God's people praise His righteous name for His powerful acts as ruler of an everlasting kingdom (145:10-21, *lesson 9*)." (*NIV Standard Lesson Commentary, p. 115*)
