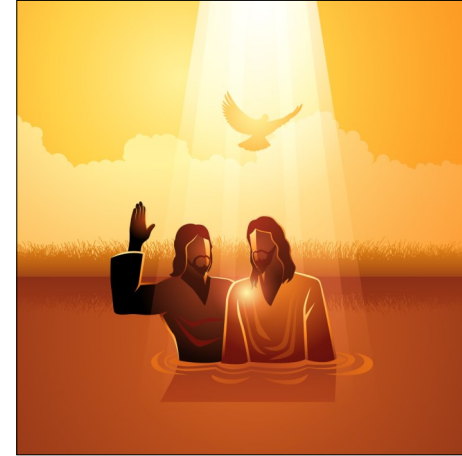

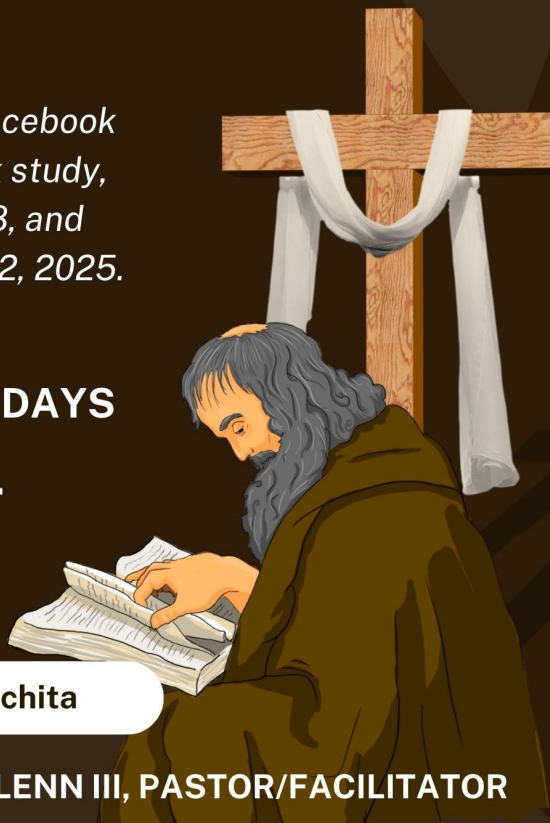

People: (singing) From all that dwell below the skies, let thy Creator's praise arise. Let thy Redeemer's name be sung, Through every land by every tongue.

Leader: And God spake all these words saying: "I am the Lord thy God who brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the House of Bondage. Thou shall have no other gods before me."

People: Lord have mercy upon us, and incline our hearts to keep this law.

Leader: Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth. Thou shall not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them. For I the Lord thy God am a jealous God visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generations of them that hate me, and showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me and keep my commandments.

People: Lord have mercy upon us, and incline our hearts to keep this law.

Leader: Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain; for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

People: Lord have mercy upon us, and incline our hearts to keep this law.

Leader: Remember the Sabbath Day to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labor and do all thy work; but the seventh day is the Sabbath of the Lord thy God; in it thou shalt not do any work; thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, nor thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates. For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested on the seventh day: Wherefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath Day and hallowed it.

People: Lord have mercy upon us, and incline our hearts to keep this law.

Hymn #376: "My soul, be on thy guard: Ten thousand foes arise; And hosts of sin are pressing hard, To draw thee from the skies."

Leader: Honor thy father and thy mother that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.

People: Lord have mercy upon us, and incline our hearts to keep this law.

The next five laws I shall read together:

Leader: Thou shalt not kill. Thou shalt not commit adultery. Thou shalt not steal. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's house; thou shall not covet thy neighbor's wife, nor his

manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his donkey, nor anything that is thy neighbor's.

People: *Lord have mercy upon us, and write these laws upon our hearts.*
